A Study On Compromise

In prayer this morning October 13, 2002, I heard the word compromise in the Spirit. The Lord said to look up the word compromise. This is the definition from Webster's. Compromise—(n) 1) a settlement in which each side gives up some demand or makes concessions. 2) a. an adjustment of opposing principles and systems, etc. by modifying some aspects of each, b. the result of such an adjustment. 3) something midway between two other things. (transitive verb) Compromised, compromising. 1) to weaken or give up (one's principles, ideals, etc.) as for reasons of expediency. After looking up compromise, this is what the Lord spoke.

“Today my Word is compromised. The world says ‘I am okay, you are okay and all are all going to heaven’. Worship what you want, and how you want to in the name of the religion you want and all will be in heaven. The “church” says homosexuality is a choice and a life style and those who practice it can be leaders in a ‘church’. All of these things have watered down my Word and are trying to make my Kingdom null and void. What is not understood is that any compromise of my Word is a compromise with the devil. I give this warning. Repent of all compromises of my Word, for you are in sin. You are no longer walking the narrow path to salvation, but the broad highway to hell.

Why do Christians and the ‘church’ compromise my Word? It is the easy way. They are not condemned by the religious ones “the church” or the world. By compromising they suffer not for my Kingdom's sake. Compromising the Word allows for the ‘church’ attendance to stay up, the money flows, the buildings are built, and the programs of traditions and doctrines go on. Those compromising are happy in this life looking forward to heaven. But on that day they will find themselves in the pits of hell, for they traveled the broad road and I knew them not for they were workers of iniquity.

I warn again, anytime my Word is compromised for the sake of unity within the “church” or the world or for any other reason, those doing the compromising

are in unrepented sin and on the road to hell.

My Kingdom is holy without compromise. My Word says if you serve me you will suffer for my Kingdom for you have decided to quit sinning. There is only one way and that is my way according to my Word and my Spirit. Those who belong to me are obeying my commandments without compromise and are living as my Son lived. They have truth and love and we abide in them and my Words abide in them and I am glorified.

I warn again. Those who compromise my Word in any manner by ignoring certain parts or refusing to preach certain parts are liars and do not live in the truth. They are living a lie on the road to hell for they repent not.

Those without compromise defend the truth and will be hated for my names sake and will suffer at the hands of the 'church' and the world. They will receive their heavenly rewards." *Matthew 5:11-12* **11** *Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. 12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.* (KJV)

"I will have my church according to my Word. My church will be the remnant that compromised not my Word and those who repented of their compromising and came into my truth. Their lips burn of my truth and they speak my truth. On those I will pour out revival.

Compromise is built on the foundations of sand and great will be its fall as my judgments amplify daily." *Matthew 7:26-27* **26** *And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:*

27 *And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.* (KJV) " **Workers of iniquity will be exposed and crushed by the rock for they were compromisers.**" Amen.

Romans 1:21-32 **21** *Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship him as God or even give him thanks. And they began to think up foolish ideas of what God was like. The result was that their minds became dark and confused. 22 Claiming to be wise, they became utter fools instead. 23 And instead of worshiping the glorious, ever-living God, they worshiped idols made to look like mere people, or birds and animals and snakes. 24 So God let them go ahead and do whatever shameful things their hearts desired. As a result, they did vile and degrading things with each other's bodies. 25 Instead of believing what they knew was the truth about God, they deliberately chose to believe lies. So they worshiped the things God made but not the Creator himself, who is to be praised forever. Amen. 26*

*That is why God abandoned them to their shameful desires. Even the women turned against the natural way to have sex and instead indulged in sex with each other. 27 And the men, instead of having normal sexual relationships with women, burned with lust for each other. Men did shameful things with other men and, as a result, suffered within themselves the penalty they so richly deserved. 28 When they refused to acknowledge God, he abandoned them to their evil minds and let them do things that should never be done. 29 Their lives became full of every kind of wickedness, sin, greed, hate, envy, murder, fighting, deception, malicious behavior, and gossip. 30 They are backstabbers, haters of God, insolent, proud, and boastful. They are forever inventing new ways of sinning and are disobedient to their parents. 31 They refuse to understand, break their promises, and are heartless and unforgiving. 32 They are fully aware of God's death penalty for those who do these things, yet they go right ahead and do them anyway. And, worse yet, they encourage others to do them, too. (NLT) **BUT those who compromise, the wrath of God will be revealed to them. Romans 1:18-19 18** *For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; 19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. (KJV)**

Then the Lord gave an example of how his Word is compromised. This is what the Lord spoke—"Many speak and preach today with salt and pepper. A little salt of truth and a lot of pepper for ear tickling. Salt is my truth and when pure salt is preached it burns those who are festered with sin and they are offended for they love their sin and the pleasures of that sin. But things are changing. The salt will be poured out and not shaken out. Salt is also my judgments. It will burn and cleanse the festered wounds of sinners who repent. The 'church' is no longer the salt of the earth. It has lost its flavor and has added other spices such as pepper. Only by repentance can it regain its flavor. Otherwise it will be thrown out and trampled underfoot as worthless. As salt is white and white represents holiness and truth, I am pouring out salt as snow in a blizzard. The salt will make the bitter sweet, if there is repentance. As many as I love, I salt for repentance." Amen.

Matthew 5:13 13 "You are the salt of the earth. But what good is salt if it has lost its flavor? Can you make it useful again? It will be thrown out and trampled underfoot as worthless. (NLT) Revelation 3:19 19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. (KJV) Compromise of the Word of God could lead to syncretism (syn-cre-tism). Syncretism is the combination or

reconciliation of differing beliefs or practices in religion, or an attempt to affect such compromise. Other words, diluting the truth of the Word for the sake of unity. The state of the “church” today-religious pluralism (Christ’s lordship is deemed irrelevant by many religious groups that believe one religion is as good as the other. His preeminence is denied by others that place the Christian stamp upon a fusion of beliefs from several religions. Usually hailed as an advance beyond apostolic Christianity, this blend promises self-fulfillment and freedom without surrender to Christ.)
