Trust God's Security And Not Man's

This dream continued most of the night. I was traveling down a road and I could see in the distance a tall crane doing something. As I approached, I saw the crane had a communications tower attached to its cable. The crane was raising the tower to a vertical position. The tower had a base attached to its bottom and as the tower came to the vertical, it hit the ground and the crane cable was no longer attached. When the tower hit with a thud, it swayed back and forth like a tree in the wind. Then I saw workmen had fastened ropes to the tower about three quarters of the way up the tower and they were pulling on the tower. It bent like a tree as it was pulled over. The workmen were seeing if the tower would clear the electric power lines. Then I saw a building sitting by the tower base. It was out of proportion in size to what one would normally see by a communications tower. Also the building was surrounded by a very sophisticated security fence that was glowing and shining brightly. The whole area looked like it was totally protected from any intrusion.

Next I was in a communications service shop. A technician was trying to tune a radio on a frequency that had no interference. I knew it had to do with part of the security system at the tower.
