

God Will Plow The Hard Ground

In prayer on June 29, 2002 the Lord spoke and said “I will plow the hard ground.” This day June 30, 2002 the Lord explained how He would plow the hard ground.

“I will plow the hard ground with My judgments. As you and your father plowed turning under the old crops and the weeds, I will turn under church doctrines and the hardened sinful hearts of this nation. I will plow the rocky ground, the red clay ground and the black loamy ground. All ground will be plowed and turned over. You will stand on the plowed ground and plant the seeds of My truth. My truth will be the rain to break up the clods of the plowed ground. The rocky ground I will use My hammer to breakup the rocks just as you used a sledgehammer to break the rocks out of the moldboards of the your plow. The ground of clay I will plow when the conditions are right according to My eyes just as you waited for the right conditions to plow the clay. It could be neither too wet nor too dry. The black ground will plow easy for me as it did for you. It will break up easy and receive the rain of My truths for the greater harvest for My pasture.

Again I say wait. Wait until the plowing starts. The plow shears are sharpened, the fields inspected, and the reports are in. The angels have their orders. The summer plowing is beginning. The fields will not be summer fallowed again. The soil will be turned and the weedy roots will be ripped out. Listen and you will hear cries of pain and sorrow because the current crop is thistles and thorns. Be ready to seed for a new crop. My crop will be made ready before I come. Prepare, for salvation is at hand.” Amen.

In prayer on July 4, 2002 the Lord asked me this question. When the stubble you were plowing would not turn under and plugged up your plow, what did you do? I said Lord, we burned the field and then plowed. The Lord said, I will burn some fields also. Later in prayer that morning the Lord said—“the fields are burning now—the forests in the west.”

Hosea 10:11-13 **11** *"Israel is like a trained heifer accustomed to treading out the grain--an easy job that she loves. Now I will put a heavy yoke on her tender neck. I will drive her in front of the plow. Israel and Judah must now break up the hard ground; their days of ease are gone.* **12** *I said, 'Plant the good seeds of righteousness, and you will harvest a crop of my love. Plow up the hard ground of your hearts, for now is the time to seek the LORD, that he may come and shower*

righteousness upon you.' **13** "But you have cultivated wickedness and raised a thriving crop of sins. You have eaten the fruit of lies--trusting in your military might, believing that great armies could make your nation safe! (NLT)

Hosea 11:9 **9** No, I will not punish you as much as my burning anger tells me to. I will not completely destroy Israel, for I am God and not a mere mortal. I am the Holy One living among you, and I will not come to destroy. (NLT)

Jeremiah 29:11 **11** For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. (NLT)

Jeremiah 29:19-23 **19** For they refuse to listen to me, though I have spoken to them repeatedly through my prophets. And you who are in exile have not listened either," says the LORD. **20** Therefore, listen to this message from the LORD, all you captives there in Babylon. **21** This is what the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, says about your prophets--Ahab son of Kolaiah and Zedekiah son of Maaseiah--who are telling you lies in my name: "I will turn them over to Nebuchadnezzar for a public execution. **22** Their terrible fate will become proverbial, so that whenever the Judean exiles want to curse someone they will say, 'May the LORD make you like Zedekiah and Ahab, whom the king of Babylon burned alive!' **23** For these men have done terrible things among my people. They have committed adultery with their neighbors' wives and have lied in my name. I am a witness to this," says the LORD. (NLT)

Jeremiah 30:11-15 **11** For I am with you and will save you, says the LORD. I will completely destroy the nations where I have scattered you, but I will not destroy you. But I must discipline you; I cannot let you go unpunished. **12** "This is what the LORD says: Yours is an incurable bruise, a terrible wound **13** There is no one to help you or bind up your injury. You are beyond the help of any medicine. **14** All your allies have left you and do not care about you anymore. I have wounded you cruelly, as though I were your enemy. For your sins are many, and your guilt is great. **15** Why do you protest your punishment--this wound that has no cure? I have had to punish you because your sins are many and your guilt is great. (NLT)

Jeremiah 35:14-17 **14** The Recabites do not drink wine because their ancestor Jehonadab told them not to. But I have spoken to you again and again, and you refuse to listen or obey. **15** I have sent you prophet after prophet to tell you to turn from your wicked ways and to stop worshiping other gods, so that you might live in peace here in the land I gave to you and your ancestors. But you would not listen to me or obey. **16** The families of Recab have obeyed their ancestor completely,

but you have refused to listen to me.' 17 "Therefore, the LORD God Almighty, the God of Israel, says: Because you refuse to listen or answer when I call, I will send upon Judah and Jerusalem all the disasters I have threatened." (NLT)
