**Matthew 7:21-23** <sup>21</sup> Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? <sup>23</sup> And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (KJV)

**Luke 17:20-24** <sup>20</sup> And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, *The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:* <sup>21</sup> *Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.* <sup>22</sup> *And he said unto the disciples, The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of man, and ye shall not see it.* <sup>23</sup> *And they shall say to you, See here; or, see there: go not after them, nor follow them.* <sup>24</sup> *For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one part under heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in his day.* (KJV)

We are to find and do the will of the Father. Then just as the Lord spoke above “You will be amazed at what My Spirit teaches and will say for you to do”. If we walk by faith and obey the Spirit, we will be a part of the body of Christ loving one another and respecting the calling and anointing each has received from the Holy Ghost. **Matthew 7:7-8** *"Keep on asking, and you will be given what you ask for. Keep on looking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened. <sup>8</sup> For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And the door is opened to everyone who knocks.* (NLT)

**Luke 18:1-8** <sup>1</sup> One day Jesus told his disciples a story to illustrate their need for constant prayer and to show them that they must never give up. <sup>2</sup> *"There was a judge in a certain city," he said, "who was a godless man with great contempt for everyone. <sup>3</sup> A widow of that city came to him repeatedly, appealing for justice against someone who had harmed her. <sup>4</sup> The judge ignored her for a while, but eventually she wore him out. 'I fear neither God nor man,' he said to himself, <sup>5</sup> 'but this woman is driving me crazy. I'm going to see that she gets justice, because she is wearing me out with her constant requests!' "* <sup>6</sup> Then the Lord said, *"Learn a lesson from this evil judge. <sup>7</sup> Even he rendered a just decision in the end, so don't you think God will surely give justice to his chosen people who plead with him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? <sup>8</sup> I tell you, he will grant justice to them quickly! But when I, the Son of Man, return, how many will I find who have faith?"* (NLT)

If we do these things, in the days to come, from the word of God it says their will be churches that think they are doing the will of God as they condemn their brothers and sisters to death that hears what the Spirit is saying to the churches and doing what the Spirit says. **John 16:2** *They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service.* (KJV) **Revelation 14:11-13** <sup>11</sup> *And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. <sup>12</sup> Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.<sup>13</sup> And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.* (KJV) The church is in denial and will not teach that Christians will die for the Lord that keep His commandments as evil arises.
