Write these things.

## Scriptures

(New Living Translation)

Matthew 6:

32 Why be like the pagans who are so deeply concerned about these things? Your heavenly Father already knows all your needs, 33 and he will give you all you need from day to day if you live for him and make the Kingdom of God your primary concern. 34 "So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today.

Romans 12:

1 And so, dear Christian friends, I plead with you to give your bodies to God. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice-the kind he will accept. When you think of what he has done for you, is this too much to ask? 2 Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will know what God wants you to do, and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect his will really is.

James 4:

7 So humble yourselves before God. Resist the Devil, and he will flee from you. 8 Draw close to God, and God will draw close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, you hypocrites.

Acts 2:

1 On the day of Pentecost, seven weeks after Jesus' resurrection, the believers were meeting together in one place.

2 Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm in the skies above them, and it filled the house where they were meeting. 3 Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. 4 And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

2 Corinthians 1:

22 and he has identified us as his own by placing the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the first installment of everything he will give us.

Galatians 4:

6 And because you Gentiles have become his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, and now you can call God your dear Father. 7 Now you are no longer a slave but God's own child. And since you are his child, everything he has belongs to you.

Galatians 3:

2 Let me ask you this one question: **Did you receive the Holy Spirit by keeping the law?** Of course not, for the Holy Spirit came upon you only after you believed the message you heard about Christ.

Acts 8 **14** When the apostles back in Jerusalem heard that the people of Samaria had accepted God's message, they sent Peter and John there. **15** As soon as they arrived, they prayed for these new Christians to receive the Holy Spirit. **16** **The Holy Spirit had not yet come upon any of them, for they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.** **17** Then Peter and John laid their hands upon these believers, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Philippians 4:

19 And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 4:

17 For the time has come for judgment, and it must begin first among God's own children. And if even we Christians must be judged, what terrible fate awaits those who have never believed God's Good News?

2 Peter 19:

19 They promise freedom, but they themselves are slaves to sin and corruption. For you are a slave to whatever controls you.

20 And when people escape from the wicked ways of the world by learning about our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and then get tangled up with sin and become its slave again, they are worse off than before. 21 It would be better if they had never known the right way to live than to know it and then reject the holy commandments that were given to them.

1 Peter 4:

1 So then, since Christ suffered physical pain, you must arm yourselves with the same attitude he had, and be ready to suffer, too. For if you are willing to suffer for Christ, you have decided to stop sinning. 2 And you won't spend the rest of your life chasing after evil desires, but you will be anxious to do the will of God. 3 You have had enough in the past of the evil things that godless people enjoy-their immorality and lust, their feasting and drunkenness and wild parties, and their terrible worship of idols.

Luke 12:

34 Wherever your treasure is, there your heart and thoughts will also be.

35 "Be dressed for service and well prepared, 36 as though you were waiting for your master to return from the wedding feast. Then you will be ready to open the door and let him in the moment he arrives and knocks.

37 There will be special favor for those who are ready and waiting for his return. I tell you, he himself will seat them, put on an apron, and serve them as they sit and eat! 38 He may come in the middle of the night or just before dawn. But whenever he comes, there will be special favor for his servants who are ready!

Revelation 12:

11 And they have defeated him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of their testimony. And they were not afraid to die.
