Traditions and Superstitions

Jeremiah 17:1 ¹ The LORD says, "My people act as though their evil ways are laws to be obeyed, inscribed with a diamond point on their stony hearts, or with an iron chisel on the corners of their altars. (NLT)

Hosea 8:12 ¹² Even though I gave them all my laws, they act as if those laws don't apply to them. (NLT)

Jeremiah 17:5-7 ⁵ This is what the LORD says: "Cursed are those who put their trust in mere humans and turn their hearts away from the LORD. ⁶ They are like stunted shrubs in the desert, with no hope for the future. They will live in the barren wilderness, on the salty flats where no one lives. ⁷ "But blessed are those who trust in the LORD and have made the LORD their hope and confidence. (NLT)

The Lord spoke this and I recorded. "Traditions and superstitions will not get one into heaven. Remember the gate is straight and the path is narrow with the word of God being the key. The bringer of the Good News has the key to give to those who will listen. If you listen and take the key then it is now your responsibility to use the key to receive your rewards and crown of life. Heed My warnings this day. Don't mix the key with the traditions of man believing that this must be done or that must be bowed to becoming superstitions fearing if I don't do I am lost. It is the key that is given and only the key that unlocks the secrets of My covenant.

Only by using the key may you have the authority and received the power that is given from heaven. If the key is diluted in the traditions and superstitions then you cannot bind on earth what is bound in heaven. The key is your read map to receive all of My promises. Only by using My key can you make yourself ready and remain ready for the final trump to sound. Traditions and superstitions bring death. Use My key to have life eternal with Me." Amen.

Zephaniah 2:2 Gather while there is still time, before judgment begins and your opportunity is blown away like chaff. Act now, before the fierce fury of the LORD falls and the terrible day of the Lord's anger begins. (NLT)

Matthew 7:16 *You can detect them by the way they act, just as you can identify a tree by its fruit. You don't pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles.* (NLT)

2 Timothy 3:5 They will act as if they are religious, but they will reject the power that could make them godly. You must stay away from people like that. (NLT)

Hebrews 2:2 *The message God delivered through angels has always proved true, and the people were punished for every violation of the law and every act of disobedience. (NLT)*

Brothers and Sisters in Christ I am only the faithful servant doing what God has called me to do. It is not by my spirit but by the Holy Spirit that these words come forth. Since God started speaking to me in August 1999, His messages of warnings have not changed. Again the Lord speaks and warns us that only Jesus Christ is the way the truth and the life. Again I say examine yourselves to see if Christ is in you and not mixing with the traditions and superstitions of man being reprobates. It is the commands of Christ by faith that we must obey. I pray that you keep yourself pure and holy by the blood of Jesus Christ doing the will of the Father. Be washed in the word of God and not the traditions and superstitions of man.

If a man or woman came into your denominational church and wanted to speak the word of God from the word of God, we must ask ourselves these questions. Would your denominational church allow that person to speak? Being allowed to speak, that person opened the word of God and began to read and teach from the word of God and it does not line up with the traditions of that denominational church what would you or the leaders of that church do? Upon denying that person to speak any longer you escort that person to an exit door of your church. What if that person upon arriving and just before that person exited his appearance changed so that his face shone like the sun and his clothing became dazzling white, where would you or your denominational church stand on judgment day?

Brothers and Sisters we must know the word God and apply it in our lives. We cannot let the traditions and superstitions of denominational churches dictate our relationship with Jesus Christ. But if we do not know the word of God with the word of God being written deep within our hearts, we will be deceived by the traditions and superstitions of man's religion. God's gifts and callings in our lives are without repentance in that God never takes them back. God calls to all His children everyday come and walk with Me and abide with Me on My spiritual mountain. Only by using the key given by God may we do so. If we mix that key given with the traditions and superstitions of man and his religion never fully completing the calling God has given us, where will we stand on judgment day?

I speak what the Holy Spirit has guided me to speak that you may be provoked in asking yourself, where do I personally stand in my relationship with Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ warned us again and again in Matthew, Mark, Luke and John what happens when we mix the traditions and superstitions of man with His teachings and commands.

2 Corinthians 11:3 ³ *But I fear that somehow you will be led away from your pure and simple devotion to Christ, just as Eve was deceived by the serpent. (NLT)*

Galatians 1:6-7 ⁶ *I am shocked that you are turning away so soon from God, who in his love and mercy called you to share the eternal life he gives through Christ. You are already following a different way* ⁷ *that pretends to be the Good News but is not the Good News at all. You are being fooled by those who twist and change the truth concerning Christ. (NLT)*

The key to the kingdom is the pure word of God being Jesus Christ who is coming for His Church. Are you ready to receive Jesus Christ this day, this hour or this minute? Amen.
