As I was praying this AM the Holy Spirit started asking me questions: “Would you buy an incomplete car, go to an incomplete doctor, dentist, or bank? Would you listen to an incomplete message of the Word?” The Holy Spirit said to look up the definition. Looking in Webster’s dictionary—**Incomplete** is lacking a part or parts, not whole, not full; unfinished; not concluded; not perfect; not through. As I was looking up the word incomplete, the Holy Spirit took my eyes to two other words—**incompetent** and **incompatible**. I was instructed to record the definitions. **Incompetent**—without adequate ability, knowledge, fitness; failing to meet requirements; incapable; unskillful. Lacking strength and sufficient flexibility to transmit pressure to change and breaking under stress. **Incompatible**—not able to exist in harmony or agreement, or getting along well together, conflicting, not corresponding to what is right.

After I finished copying down the definitions, the Holy Spirit said “The denominational churches today are incomplete, incompetent and incompatible with the Word and what I am about to do concerning judgments upon this nation, Churches and Christians.” Also the Holy Spirit confirmed what I had been saying for He spoke—“If a person of any religion follows its doctrine or doctrines as written; those persons are called radicals and terrorists.” The Holy Spirit was showing me that this also includes Christians following the Word of God by obeying the Word of God.

Then I saw a highway with much trash and many buckets along side the roadway. I asked, what does that represent? The Lord said—“The buckets are Christians who have given up their incompleteness in the judgments coming. For when you walk in incompleteness with Me, it is a fine line or tight rope to heaven and many fall off”. *Luke 8:6, 13 6 Other seed fell on shallow soil with underlying rock. This seed began to grow, but soon it withered and died for lack of moisture. 13 The rocky soil represents those*

who hear the message with joy. But like young plants in such soil, their roots don't go very deep. They believe for a while, but they wilt when the hot winds of testing blow. (NLT)
