The Holy Spirit reiterated this day—“Every new Christian’s responsibility is to seek communion with the Lord. He is to be one with the Lord through Jesus Christ. He is to have communion Spiritually and to partake of the communion elements. This is accomplished by doing the 1st six of the seven basic steps to salvation and maturity. Otherwise that Christian is in sin. The first six steps must be done before they can do step seven, which is communion with God in the Spirit and partaking of the elements without drinking damnation to themselves.”

Interlude

“If the houses being built in My name and the builders are in sin and they give me glory for their success, am I the one doing the blessing? Doing what is right in their own eyes, they are leading the ones in that house not to salvation but to damnation. Who is their leader they give the glory to? Who have they bowed down before? They know Me not, they are not born of the Spirit and they have not My power, only My words. They do not My works or greater works. Again, who do they bow down to and serve? Think about it.”

Interlude

“Do not pray for them. My judgments are set. They will hear My truth. They will be offered knowledge and if they repent, they will not be destroyed. Woe to those who deny the knowledge. They will be sent down to the grave and hell only to be raised, then judged and thrown into the lake of fire.” Amen

The Holy Spirit guided me to use these Scriptures:

Judges 17:6 ⁶ *In those days there was no king in Israel, but every man did that which was right in his own eyes. (KJV) We have a King today and his name is Jesus Christ, but are we letting him be our King and do we accept his commands as given in the Word of God and by the Holy Spirit?*

Hosea 4:6-9 **6** *My people are being destroyed because they don't know me [lack of knowledge]. It is all your fault, you priests, for you yourselves refuse to know me. Now I refuse to recognize you as my priests. Since you have forgotten the laws of your God, I will forget to bless your children.* **7** *The more priests there are, the more they sin against me. They have exchanged the glory of God for the disgrace of idols.* **8** *"The priests get fed when the people sin and bring their sin offerings to them. So the priests are glad when the people sin!"* **9** *'Like priests, like people'--since the priests are wicked, the people are wicked, too. So now I will punish both priests and people for all their wicked deeds. (NLT)*

Isaiah 5:11-25 **11** *Woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, that they may follow strong drink; that continue until night, till wine inflame them!* **12** *And the harp, and the viol, the tabret, and pipe, and wine, are in their feasts: but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.* **13** **Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because they have no knowledge:** and their honourable men are famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst. **14** **Therefore hell hath enlarged herself,** and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

15 *And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled:* **16** *But the LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God that is holy shall be sanctified in righteousness.* **17** *Then shall the lambs feed after their manner, and the waste places of the fat ones shall strangers eat.* **18** *Woe unto them that draw iniquity with cords of vanity, and sin as it were with a cart rope:* **19** *That say, Let him make speed, and hasten his work, that we may see it: and let the counsel of the Holy One of Israel draw nigh and come, that we may know it!* **20** *Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!* **21** *Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!* **22** *Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink:* **23** *Which justify the wicked for reward, and take away the righteousness of the righteous from him!* **24** *Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, so their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.* **25** *Therefore is the*

anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcasses were torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still. (KJV)
