When we came out from the womb being born, we knew nothing being dependent upon the one who birthed us. When we are born again, becoming a new spirit in Christ, we know nothing about his kingdom and are dependent upon brothers and sisters around us.

After our natural birth, our father and mother taught us the basics of life. That training gave us knowledge and wisdom being able to live in the physical world upon this earth. In their training from our youth, we learned self-sufficiency maturing into adults knowing right from wrong according to what our parents taught us. The life we live in the physical world is influenced by our parent's training, schooling, and by our peers from school, the work place, church and those we socialize with.
