How Much Longer?

God has held nothing back in the dreams, visions and teachings of His truth and the sins of His people. I fear for God's people who claim but do not have salvation because of the rebellion of disobedience to his word.

In my prayer closet this day I knew I was to turn on my computer and write what the Lord wanted spoken. The first thing the Holy Ghost gave me was the title of what I was to write. God changes not. We have changed not and seem to always follow the examples of Israel which is not good. Please pray to God in the name of Jesus Christ that your eyes and ears be opened as you read that you may find the truth and obey the truth to be saved if Jesus Christ comes for His Church this day.

We Christians made of flesh and blood created in the image of God have evil pastimes that are abominations to God. The prayer Jesus Christ prayed in John chapter 17 has not been answered because of our sins. Christians are not of one mind in Jesus Christ being in unity with love worshipping God in spirit and truth. The Church Jesus Christ is coming for is not ready. How much longer before these things are so?

How much longer are we (Christians) going to argue about religious pedigrees? How much longer are we (Christians) going to have an anger of rage and jealousy rise up when a brother or sister wants to share a revelation from God by the Holy Ghost that does not line up with our religion? How much longer are we (Christians) going to argue about what day to worship God? How much longer are we (Christians) going to argue about what Jesus Christ accomplished on the cross? How much longer are we (Christians) going to claim we have faith but will not walk the narrow path? How much longer are we (Christians) going to claim salvation but will not worship God in spirit and truth by being born of the Spirit? How much longer are we (Christians) going to say I am a Baptist, a Methodist, a Presbyterian, a Pentecost, a Lutheran and on and on? How much longer are Christians going to convert and follow Jewish customs and traditions? How much longer are Christians who are these converts going to twist, bend, and distort the word of God saying we must follow certain parts of the Law of Moses? How much longer are Christians going to deny the greatest gift after salvation that Jesus Christ has to offer us and that being the baptism of the Holy Ghost? How much longer are the churches going to deny the gifts that the Father and the Son gives to the churches? How much longer will the churches deny the gifts that the Holy Ghost has to give to the churches? How much longer are

the appointed leaders of the churches going to act like hirelings fearing men who control the church and not God? How much longer are Christians going to “cherry-pick¹” the word of God denying the whole truth of the word of God? How much longer are Christians going to claim the promises of Jesus Christ but continue to deny and obey His holy commands? How much longer are the churches going to be silent allowing Satan to be a roaring lion devouring the minds and lives of Christians and the world by corrupt governments, schools, entertainment media, news media and misguided law enforcement agencies? How much longer are churches going to be cowards bowing down to the commands of secular governments while holding the truth of the word of God in their hearts? How much longer are Christians and churches going to love this life and their possessions not doing what Jesus Christ, Paul, Peter, James or Stephen did?

How much longer will God allow church leaders and Christians to bend, twist and distort the word of God to satisfy the flesh man? How much longer will God allow Christians to claim Jesus Christ but have conditional love in their hearts for other Christians? How much longer will God allow name brand churches to slice off a piece Jesus Christ to satisfy their doctrines in the flesh by making Jesus Christ in their image? How much longer will God allow preachers to preach at funerals that we will all (sinners and non sinners alike) be united in heaven because that is God’s plan? How much longer will God allow Christians to remain blind and deaf doing salvation their own way? How much longer will God allow Christians and churches to claim the promises of Jesus Christ as the refuse to do the commands of Jesus Christ? How much longer will God allow Christians and churches to love this life and their possessions refusing to do what is commanded in the word of God?

God blessed Israel and Judah and they prospered becoming rich in all things. Then Israel and Judah kicked God out and fell into sin. Israel and Judah disregarded the warnings from prophet after prophet that was sent from God. America with her Christians and churches follow the examples of Israel and Judah. Do we as Christians think we are immune from our sins listed in the questions above and will not be judged? We are fools if we think that is so. **Hosea 13:6-8** ⁶ *According to their pasture, so were they filled; they were filled, and their heart was exalted; therefore have they forgotten me.* ⁷ *Therefore I will be unto them as a lion: as a leopard by the way will I observe them:* ⁸ *I will meet them as a bear that is bereaved of her whelps, and will rend the caul of their heart, and there will I devour them like a lion: the wild beast shall tear them.* (KJV) God sends His prophets in this day because God changes not. It is by God’s prophets that His word is empowered. **Hosea 6:5** *I sent my prophets to cut you to pieces. I have slaughtered you with my words, threatening you with death. My judgment will strike you as surely as day follows night.* (NLT) Have we (Christians) heeded the words of God by His prophets and repented? Or are we being judged just as Israel and Judah were judged? How much longer before we wakeup from our sleep of sin and rebellion? Read what Paul wrote about the consequences of those who live for themselves and refuse to obey the truth and practice evil deeds in Romans 2:1-11.

America has fallen from God’s grace because we the people have forgotten our roots and our Godly foundation. Worst yet the current corrupt systems of government and schools don’t even teach or are allowed to teach the truth about what our relationship should be with God. God has been kicked out and other gods are worshipped. The churches of America have fallen from God’s grace because Christians have forgotten their roots and Godly foundation. Worst yet the corrupt priesthood don’t even teach the whole truth of the word of God but only the most

desirable scriptures to appease the flesh of man. Jesus Christ is barred as the head of the church because the church is not according to the word of God. We the people (Christians and non Christians) have forgotten that America is a republic and not a democracy founded on the word of God. We (Christians and the churches) have forgotten that the Church Jesus Christ is coming for is a theocracy ruled from heaven by appointed leaders God and Christ sets in His Church.

The Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost are no longer welcome in this nation that shouts "God Bless America". When God is done with His judgments, it is striking us as day follows night, we the people will be brought to our knees. What will be your answer these four questions?

1. Brothers and sisters in Christ is the church you attend a church of Jesus Christ? Yes or no.
2. Brothers and sisters in Christ is the church you attend a church of Jesus Christ according to the word of God? Yes or no.
3. Brothers and sisters in Christ is the church you attend a church of Jesus Christ according to the word of God with members present that God and Jesus Christ sets in the church? Yes or no.
4. Brothers and sisters in Christ is the church you attend a church of Jesus Christ according to the word of God with members present that God and Jesus Christ sets in the church and with the gifts of the Holy Ghost operating in that church? Yes or no.

If you answered question four yes, then you will have quit doing the things asked in the questions that are abominations to God. You have let the Holy Ghost be your teacher so that all things you speak and do will line up with the word of God. You will no longer bend, twist and distort the word of God that fits the beliefs of your flesh man. The church that is doing all that is asked in question four would be preaching Paul's gospel and will not be judged with the world. The church that is doing all that is asked in question four will have the five fold ministry of the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and the teaches and the nine gifts of the Spirit functioning within. **Romans 2:16** *In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.* (KJV) How much longer will it be before we (Christians) answer yes to question four?

How much longer will it be before Jesus Christ will have His Church that will take the gospel of the kingdom to the world so that the end will come? How much longer will it be before we (Christians) hurry and look forward to that day when God will set the heavens on fire and the elements will melt away in the flames? How much longer will it be before God's judgments are complete upon this nation and the churches of this nation? How much longer will it be before we repent of our rebellion and serve the living, holy and righteous God with our hearts and not our lips?

If we (Christians) would die this day in God's judgments where will our eternal home be, heaven or hell and later the lake of fire? How much longer will it be before we (Christians) realize that we must work out our own salvation with fear and trembling to be righteous being

barely saved? How much longer will it be before Christ comes? Only the Father knows the day. How much longer will it be before you are ready to receive Christ when He comes?

Let us look at what the inspired word of God teaches about God, truth, love, the fear of God and what happens to the wicked in these four verses from *Psalms 145:17-20* (KJV).

17 The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.

God is the creator of all things in heaven and on earth. God can do no wrong. God loves the sinner and the saved alike but sin separates us from God. God has His order written in His word that we must do. God disciplines us when we sin against His word and His order of things that we may repent. Because of our rebellion, God judges us and that is why many are sick, weak and dying. If we repent of our sins and rebellion, God is full of grace and mercy and will forgive us. How much longer will we (Christians) continue in our rebellion not obeying the word of God and not knowing God in spirit and truth?

18 The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.

We must be in God's truth for God to draw nigh to us. God's truth is His written word, His living word Jesus Christ and what the Holy Ghost teaches us from heaven. If we are in sin of disobedience to His word, we are separated from God by that sin. Review verse # 17. How much longer will we (Christians) continue in our rebellion not obeying the word of God and not knowing God in spirit and truth?

19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

If we fear man and obey the doctrines of a church that teaches not the whole truth, how can God hear our cry and save us? If we fear God and work out our own salvation with fear and trembling by obeying whole word of God being the truth, God will save us from eternal damnation as we cry out to him. Then if our desires line up with God's will, those desires will be fulfilled. How much longer will we (Christians) continue in our rebellion not obeying the word of God and not knowing God in spirit and truth?

20 The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

We can only truly love God if we obey the commands of Jesus Christ otherwise our love is not pure and holy. God will destroy all of the wicked and send them to hell and finally into the lake of fire. If we are wicked by sinning against God or His word not having pure and holy love, we will be judged with the world. Those churches who preach that we can live our life walking the broad path will cause those who listen to be damned and the preachers doubly damned. Those preachers that preach at funerals that all are going to heaven and will be joined together preach their own damnation. We all live once then judgment and judgment is final. If our name is in the book of life, we will have eternal life with Christ because we love and obey God. If our name is not in the book of life, our place will be in the lake of fire for eternity. How much longer will we (Christians) continue in our rebellion not obeying the word of God and not knowing God in spirit and truth?

God does not have a long list that we must do to be saved after confessing Jesus Christ as those were under the law. We must walk by faith doing our works of obeying Christ who is the truth having love for all. Again this day I remind you of these seven basic steps to maturity as taught to me by the Holy Ghost. Over and over again I have reminded brothers and sisters as directed by the Holy Ghost of these steps in other teachings. It is the will of God that Christians understand and do all of these steps. Otherwise we (Christians) can never leave the principles of

the doctrine of Christ going on unto perfection. How much longer are we (Christians) going to eat the crumbs from our Master's table when the Father wants us to feast at His table?

1. Must be born again. *John 3:3* Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.** (KJV) *Romans 10:9-10*⁹ That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (KJV)

2. Must be born of water with earthly witnesses. *John 3:5* Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.** (KJV)

3. Must be born of the spirit with heavenly witnesses speaking in new tongues. *John 3:5* Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.** (KJV) *Acts 19:2-7*² He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. ³ And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. ⁴ Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. ⁵ When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ⁶ **And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.** ⁷ And all the men were about twelve. (KJV)

4. Must put off the old man of flesh and put on the new man of the spirit in the image of Christ. *Ephesians 4:22-24*²² That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; ²³ **And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;** ²⁴ And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. (KJV) *2 Corinthians 5:17* Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: **old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.** (KJV) *Romans 6:6-8*⁶ Our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. ⁷ For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin. ⁸ And since we died with Christ, we know we will also share his new life. (NLT)

5. Must be washed in the word of God to know the doctrine of Christ. *Ephesians 5:25-27*²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; ²⁶ That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. (KJV)

6. Must spend time in your prayer closet to draw near to God to know God. *Matthew 6:5-7*⁵ And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. ⁶ But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly. ⁷ But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. (KJV)

7. Must partake of communion by the breaking of bread and drinking of the wine daily in remembrance of the death of Jesus Christ until he comes again. *Acts 2:46-47*⁴⁶ They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity-- ⁴⁷ all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their group those who were being saved. (NLT) *1 Corinthians 11:23-26*²⁴ and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body,

which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." 25 In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and you, sealed by the shedding of my blood. Do this in remembrance of me as often as you drink it." 26 For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again. (NLT)

How much longer are we (Christians) going to say "I don't believe in all of these seven steps" ignoring the word of God? How much longer will we (Christians) ignore the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost in our lives? How much longer are we (Christians) going to teach and preach against the truth of the of the apostles and prophets and the baptism of the Holy Ghost saying that died with the first twelve apostles of Jesus Christ? How much longer will we (Christians) deny the whole truth being in rebellion against God? How much longer will we (Christians) only agree to disagree? We must heed the warning Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 11:27-32 of taking the bread and drinking of the cup unworthily. They were guilty of sinning against the body of Christ and many were weak, sick and some have died. God changes not and Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. If we sin, these same things can happen to us as God disciplines us because God loves us. The questions asked throughout should be meditated and prayed about in our prayer closet that we may examine ourselves and repent to be the kind of Christians Jesus Christ prayed about in John chapter 17. If we do so, then we will be the kind of Christians to be the Church Jesus Christ is coming for. How much longer until we (Christians) are going to be one with Christ and not claiming I am a follower of denomination A-Z? How much longer will you gamble with your salvation?

Remember the word of God is the truth that is unchangeable by Christians or churches in their thinking.

Hebrews 4:11 Let us do our best to enter that place of rest. For anyone who disobeys God, as the people of Israel did, will fall. (NLT)

Ephesians 5:6 Don't be fooled by those who try to excuse these sins, for the terrible anger of God comes upon all those who disobey him. (NLT)

Romans 2:8-11 8 But he will pour out his anger and wrath on those who live for themselves, who refuse to obey the truth and practice evil deeds. 9 There will be trouble and calamity for everyone who keeps on sinning--for the Jew first and also for the Gentile. 10 But there will be glory and honor and peace from God for all who do good--for the Jew first and also for the Gentile. 11 For God does not show favoritism. (NLT)

Romans 11:22 Notice how God is both kind and severe. He is severe to those who disobeyed, but kind to you as you continue to trust in his kindness. But if you stop trusting, you also will be cut off. (NLT)
