Do you walk and talk to the Lord each day? If you do, are you ready to believe by faith when the Lord gives you revelation knowledge? Before going to bed the other night, I was walking outside talking to the Lord. The Lord spoke very briefly about man being made in His image. I said to the Lord “wow that answers many other questions”. This day in my prayer closet the Lord said to write. As I wrote the Lord expanded what He spoke to me that night. I can already hear the murmurings and grumbings of disagreement. Read what the Lord spoke and you will see why. But after the Lord spoke what He did, I was directed to provide scripture supporting what He spoke.

### **In The Image of God**

“My children are sick in their flesh because they lack knowledge and wisdom. They are not made in My image. What you say? Then you say ‘man was made in God’s image after His likeness’. Does My word lie? Does My word contradict itself? Who truly knows My word? Who truly knows Me? My word does not lie or contradict. If you know My word, then you know it says I am a Spirit. If you know Me, then you have been born of the Spirit. This is how you are made in My image by being born of the Spirit. Adam was from the dirt of the earth to be flesh. Adam walked in the Spirit with Me until he ate the forbidden fruit. He was no longer in My image being of the Spirit. Since Adam until My Son was born of the flesh all men walked in the flesh. Yes, there were a few on whom I poured out My Spirit upon that they walked in My image being of the Spirit.

Again I say, to be made in My image you must be born of the Spirit. This is possible by My Son’s death on the cross. Since My Son’s resurrection, these are the last days. I have and I will continue to pour out My Spirit upon all flesh that seek Me by My word. My word is truth whether you know it, obey it or twist it. Think upon these words I have spoken. Those born of the Spirit will understand as they walk in My image. Those born again walking in the flesh will deny My words. There are earthly bodies of flesh and there are heavenly bodies for those who have died. But those who have received the Holy Spirit by being born of the Spirit can have a taste of what these heavenly bodies will be like.

Remember My Son was a Spirit with Me in the beginning. He was born of woman being flesh. He was born of water and Spirit. He died so the Holy Spirit could come. He showed the way it must be done to be made in My image to worship Me in Spirit and truth. My word shows what My will is. My word will keep you from working iniquity if you obey. I am a Spirit. My Son came born of the flesh and showed you how to be made in My image by being made like you. My Son is coming again for those who have done My will having obeyed My Word.” Amen

## What the Lord spoke agrees with His word.

**Hosea 4:6** <sup>6</sup> My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children. (KJV)

**Isaiah 5:13-14** <sup>13</sup> Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because *they have* no knowledge: and their honourable men *are* famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst. <sup>14</sup> Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it. (KJV)

**Genesis 1:26-27** <sup>26</sup> And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. <sup>27</sup> So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (KJV)

**Matthew 3:13-17** <sup>13</sup> Then Jesus went from Galilee to the Jordan River to be baptized by John.

<sup>14</sup> But John didn't want to baptize him. "I am the one who needs to be baptized by you," he said, "so why are you coming to me?" <sup>15</sup> But Jesus said, "It must be done, because we must do everything that is right." So then John baptized him. <sup>16</sup> After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him. <sup>17</sup> And a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son, and I am fully pleased with him." (NLT)

**John 3:**<sup>34</sup> For he is sent by God. He speaks God's words, for God's Spirit is upon him without measure or limit. (NLT)

**Matthew 7:21-23**<sup>21</sup> Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? <sup>23</sup> And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (KJV)

**John 3:3-6** <sup>3</sup> Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. <sup>4</sup> Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? <sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. <sup>6</sup> That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. (KJV)

**John 4:23-24** <sup>23</sup> But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. <sup>24</sup> God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. (KJV)

**John 1:1-14** <sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> The same was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. <sup>4</sup> In him was life; and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. <sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe. <sup>8</sup> He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. <sup>9</sup> That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. <sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. <sup>11</sup> He came unto his own, and his own received him not. <sup>12</sup> But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: <sup>13</sup> Which were born, not of blood,

nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. <sup>14</sup> And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. (KJV)

**Acts 2:16-21** <sup>16</sup> But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; <sup>17</sup> And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: <sup>18</sup> And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: <sup>19</sup> And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: <sup>20</sup> The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: <sup>21</sup> And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. (KJV)

**Acts 19:1-6** <sup>1</sup> And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, <sup>2</sup> He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. <sup>3</sup> And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. <sup>4</sup> Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. <sup>5</sup> When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. <sup>6</sup> And when Paul had laid *his* hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied. (KJV)

**1 Corinthians 15:12-20** <sup>12</sup> But tell me this--since we preach that Christ rose from the dead, why are some of you saying there will be no resurrection of the dead? <sup>13</sup> For if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised either. <sup>14</sup> And if Christ was not raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your trust in God is useless. <sup>15</sup> And we apostles would all be lying about God, for we have said that God raised Christ from the grave, but that can't be true if there is no resurrection of the dead. <sup>16</sup> If there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised. <sup>17</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless, and you are still under condemnation for your sins. <sup>18</sup> In that case, all who have died believing in Christ have perished! <sup>19</sup> And if we have hope in Christ only for this life, we are the most miserable people in the world. <sup>20</sup> But the fact is that Christ has been raised from the dead. He has become the first of a great harvest of those who will be raised to life again. (NLT)

**1 Corinthians 15:**<sup>22</sup> Everyone dies because all of us are related to Adam, the first man. But all who are related to Christ, the other man, will be given new life. (NLT)

**1 Corinthians 46-49** <sup>45</sup> The Scriptures tell us, "The first man, Adam, became a living person." But the last Adam--that is, Christ--is a life-giving Spirit. <sup>46</sup> What came first was the natural body, then the spiritual body comes later. <sup>47</sup> Adam, the first man, was made from the dust of the earth, while Christ, the second man, came from heaven. <sup>48</sup> Every human being has an earthly body just like Adam's, but our heavenly bodies will be just like Christ's. <sup>49</sup> Just as we are now like Adam, the man of the earth, so we will someday be like Christ, the man from heaven. (NLT)

**2 Corinthians 5:1-10** <sup>1</sup> For we know that when this earthly tent we live in is taken down--when we die and leave these bodies--we will have a home in heaven, an eternal body made for us by God himself and not by human hands. <sup>2</sup> We grow weary in our present bodies, and we long for the day when we will put on our heavenly bodies like new clothing. <sup>3</sup> For we will not be spirits without bodies, but we will put on new heavenly bodies. <sup>4</sup> Our dying bodies make us groan and sigh, but it's not that we want to die and have no bodies at all. We want to slip into our new bodies so that these dying bodies will be swallowed up by everlasting life. <sup>5</sup> God himself has prepared us

for this, and as a guarantee he has given us his Holy Spirit. <sup>6</sup> So we are always confident, even though we know that as long as we live in these bodies we are not at home with the Lord. <sup>7</sup> That is why we live by believing and not by seeing. <sup>8</sup> Yes, we are fully confident, and we would rather be away from these bodies, for then we will be at home with the Lord. <sup>9</sup> So our aim is to please him always, whether we are here in this body or away from this body. <sup>10</sup> For we must all stand before Christ to be judged. We will each receive whatever we deserve for the good or evil we have done in our bodies. (NLT)

**1 Thessalonians 4:13-18** <sup>13</sup> And now, brothers and sisters, I want you to know what will happen to the Christians who have died so you will not be full of sorrow like people who have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus comes, God will bring back with Jesus all the Christians who have died. <sup>15</sup> I can tell you this directly from the Lord: We who are still living when the Lord returns will not rise to meet him ahead of those who are in their graves. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the call of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God. First, all the Christians who have died will rise from their graves. <sup>17</sup> Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air and remain with him forever. <sup>18</sup> So comfort and encourage each other with these words. (NLT)

**1 Timothy 3:**<sup>16</sup> Without question, this is the great mystery of our faith: Christ appeared in the flesh and was shown to be righteous by the Spirit. He was seen by angels and was announced to the nations. He was believed on in the world and was taken up into heaven. (NLT)

**2 Timothy 2:**<sup>8</sup> Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel: (KJV)

How can we as Christians live a life in the Spirit that Paul wrote about in Romans 8:1-17? If we have not been made into His image after the likeness of His image, we walk in the flesh being carnally minded. The word of God is truth. If we as Christians refuse to obey or twist the word God to satisfy the wants of the flesh, then we are dead without the Holy Spirit not made into the image of God. I conclude with verses 9-14 from Romans 8 from the word of God.

**Romans 8:9-14** <sup>9</sup> But ye are not in the flesh, **but in the Spirit**, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the **Spirit of Christ**, he is none of his. <sup>10</sup> And if Christ *be* in you, the body *is* dead because of sin; **but the Spirit is life** because of righteousness. <sup>11</sup> But **if the Spirit of him** that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies **by his Spirit that dwelleth in you**. <sup>12</sup> Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. <sup>13</sup> For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: **but if ye through the Spirit** do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. <sup>14</sup> For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. (KJV)
