Again this day the Holy Spirit taught me about the thousand year reign of Jesus Christ on this earth and why the thousand years.

Only by God's mercy many will have salvation and be with Christ on earth for a thousand years, but their flesh never was crucified in their life on this earth. They never allowed their flesh to die (thinking earthly thoughts) to let their spirit man rise up (heavenly thoughts in communion with Jesus Christ by the Holy Ghost while alive on the earth). And by God's mercy in those one thousand years all will be tested and those whose flesh was never crucified will be preached the truth that they might repent and not follow the devil when he is loosened at the end of the thousand years. Those who fail the test and have not repented will not be allowed to enter into the heavenly Jerusalem to drink from the living waters. They will set outside the gates seeing but never entering into the kingdom of heaven the New Jerusalem. It is when we enter into the New Jerusalem that all of God's promises will be fulfilled.

Revelation 21:1-10 ¹ *And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.* ² *And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.*

³ *And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people,*

and God himself shall be with them, and be their God **4** And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. **5** And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. **6** And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. **7** He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. **8** But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. **9** And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife. **10** And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, (KJV) **Note**—We will receive all of God's promises only by being overcomers loving our lives not unto death obeying and living our lives as Christ lived his in the gospels.

Revelation 22:14-15 **14** Blessed are those who wash their robes so they can enter through the gates of the city and eat the fruit from the tree of life. **15** Outside the city are the dogs--the sorcerers, the sexually immoral, the murderers, the idol worshipers, and all who love to live a lie. (NLT) **Note**—We all live a lie if we love our flesh more than spirit never coming into the truth by obeying the commands of Christ by being born of both water and the Spirit.

1 Corinthians 1:29 **29** That no flesh should glory in his presence. (KJV) **Note**—This is both our flesh and blood bodies as well as the fleshly thoughts in our minds

1 Peter 4:6 **6** That is why the Good News was preached even to those who have died--so that although their bodies were punished with death, they could still live in the spirit as God does. (NLT) Jesus spoke in John 4:23-24 **23** But the hour cometh, and now is, **when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.** **24** God is a Spirit: and **they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.** (KJV) Jesus spoke in John 6:63 **63** **It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I**

speaking unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. (KJV) **Note**—Jesus was teaching his disciples that what he spoke was from the Father by the Holy Spirit. Jesus was born of the Spirit when he came up out of the water after John baptized him and by the Holy Spirit he received anointing without measure to do the will of the Father in heaven. He showed us by example even though we are flesh and blood we can serve God in spirit and truth, but only if we wait for the power of the Holy Ghost to come upon us as he did at the day of Pentecost and upon the Christians in the early church being taught and obeying the truth by the apostles called of God.

In prayer I asked the Lord why that when I am tired or when I was taking pain pills after surgery it was easier to communicate with him by the Holy Ghost. His answer was, “that at the time the flesh was weak and put under allowing the spirit man to rise up fighting the flesh. As long as the flesh in control remaining proud, the spirit man is squelched and we are without communication with the Holy Ghost.”

We only know God by worshipping him in the spirit and the truth. Only when we are born of the Spirit, we have the power to overcome the flesh to keep it under allowing our spirit man to live in unity with God’s Spirit. Keeping the flesh under is a daily fight so that we may commune with God by the Holy Spirit.

Romans 8:1-16¹ *There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.*
² *For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.* ³ *For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:* ⁴ *That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.* ⁵ ***For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.*** ⁶ *For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.* ⁷ *Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.* ⁸ *So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.* ⁹ *But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.* ¹⁰ *And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.* ¹¹ *But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised*

up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. **12** Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. **13** For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. **14** For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. **15** For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. **16** The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: (KJV) **Note**—Our spirit man can only overcome our flesh man if we obey Jesus Christ and tarry to receive power from the Holy Ghost. As John baptized with water, Jesus Christ said we will be baptized with the Holy Ghost by being born of the Spirit. Those born of the Spirit will speak in tongues. Read the Book of Acts. This is the Word of God and God does not lie.

1 Corinthians 15:50 **50** Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. (KJV) **Note**—Only those born of the Spirit can inherit the kingdom of God entering into the New Jerusalem.

Galatians 3:2-3 **2** This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? **3** Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh? (KJV) **Note**—If we have never been born of the Spirit as commanded by Jesus Christ, we are only of the flesh being imperfect never walking in the Spirit. But Paul writing the Galatians makes the statement they began worshipping God in the Spirit. If they were worshipping God in the spirit and truth they were born of the Spirit. This we know Paul taught and made sure those he didn't teach but were taught by someone were born of the Spirit as commanded by Jesus. See Acts 19:2.

Galatians 5:16-17 **16** This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. **17** For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. (KJV) **Note**—To walk in the Spirit we must be born of the Spirit as commanded by Jesus Christ to overcome the flesh and obey the complete teaching of Jesus Christ. Then we can do all the things we should.

Galatians 5:24-25 **24** Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. **25** If we are living now by the Holy Spirit, let us follow the

Holy Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. (NLT) **Note**—To live by the Holy Spirit we must be born of the Spirit as commanded by Jesus Christ.

Galatians 6:8 **8** *For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.* (KJV) **Note**—If we are never born of the Spirit, we sow by the flesh reaping corruption that ends in death.

Philippians 3:3 **3** *For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.* (KJV) **Note**—Only if we are born of the Spirit.

1 Timothy 3:16 **16** *Without question, this is the great mystery of our faith: Christ appeared in the flesh and was shown to be righteous by the Spirit. He was seen by angels and was announced to the nations. He was believed on in the world and was taken up into heaven.* (NLT) **Note**—Jesus Christ set the example for us to follow. He was born of the Spirit after John baptized him receiving anointing without measure (power and ability) from the Father in heaven to do the Father's will on earth in a flesh and blood body and he was without sin.

1 John 2:16-17 **16** *For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.* **17** *And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.* (KJV) **Note**—How do we know the will of the Father? We must be born of the Spirit as commanded by Jesus Christ to have communications with the Father and Christ by the Holy Ghost who is the teacher and revealer. Being born of the Spirit we will know and do the will of the Father as Jesus did..

John 3:6-8 **6** *That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.* **7** *Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.* **8** *The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.* (KJV) **Note**—Being born of the Spirit is from heaven being a heavenly experience. And to know if we are born of the Spirit there must be evidence or witness just as those born of water have earthly physical evidence or witness. Those born of the Spirit will speak in tongues by the Spirit and that is their spiritual witness from heaven.

Luke 11:11-13 **11** *If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a*

*serpent? 12 Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? (KJV) **Note**—Jesus said we must be born of the Spirit and he also said we must keep on asking until we receive the Holy Spirit and it will be with the evidence of speaking in tongues. See Acts 19:2-7 and learn from Paul's teaching and example.*
