In prayer today the Holy Spirit spoke—“When you walk in the Spirit, your thoughts, ways and plans are in alignment with Me. When you walk in the flesh, your thoughts, ways and plans align with the world. The flesh and the spirit will always be at odds. To walk in the Spirit you must be born of the Spirit and you will speak in tongues. If you refuse tongues you are **still born [dead]** in the Spirit. Wherever you time is spent walking that is what you are. Walking in the flesh more than the Spirit, you love and serve the world. Walking in the Spirit more than in the flesh, you love and serve My Kingdom. Wherever your thoughts and your eyes are focused, that is who you serve.”

Matthew 6:24 24 "No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money. (NLT) Matthew 6:19-20 19 "Don't store up treasures here on earth, where they can be eaten by moths and get rusty, and where thieves break in and steal. 20 Store your treasures in heaven, where they will never become moth-eaten or rusty and where they will be safe from thieves. (NLT)

The Lord reminded me again the conditions of the church by reading Hosea 4:6-19 again. Reading Proverbs 8:35-36 about wisdom calling out [*Proverbs 8:35-36 35 For whoever finds me finds life and wins approval from the LORD. 36 But those who miss me have injured themselves. All who hate me love death.* (NLT)]. Wisdom is the Holy Spirit calling and warning in those verses. Those who miss wisdom hate wisdom and love death. The Lord took me to *Matthew 12:31-32 31 "Every sin or blasphemy can be forgiven--except blasphemy against the Holy Spirit, which can never be forgiven. 32 Anyone who blasphemes against me, the Son of Man, can be forgiven, but blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will*

never be forgiven, either in this world or in the world to come. (NLT). The Lord said look up the word blasphemy. Webster's defines it as—1: the act of insulting or showing contempt or lack of reverence for God 2: irreverence toward something considered sacred or inviolable. The Lord said the verses mean just what they say. I asked why the blasphemes against Jesus can be forgiven. The Lord said—"He was born of the flesh to take away the sins of the world and because He was flesh He forgives our sins against Him." I fear for those who has cursed and made fun of the Holy Spirit, his gifts and the evidence of his baptism, the speaking in tongues that they are lost souls. Proverbs says if you hate wisdom you love death.
