Have your bible at hand to find the truth that it may set you free from the ties that bind you to this world. Otherwise what you think you have will be the opposite of you thinking.

Is Your Ticket Punched?

"I am a God of mercy and love forgiving the sins of many who have confessed My Son as their Lord and Savior. In layman's terms 'that is your free ticket to salvation'. You did nothing to earn that ticket. But to keep that ticket, you must obey what is written in My book the Holy Bible. If you labor not, yes I said labor, with your heart's desire to do and be what My word says, then again in layman's terms 'you will not get your ticket punched for entry.' The door will be shut and no amount of knocking, pleading and crying will get you in.

Today, now this hour, this minute desire to read My word and begin to obey. Then you will be working out your own salvation with fear and trembling to become holy as I am holy by the blood of My Son Jesus Christ. I can share with you by telling you about the number of multitudes thinking they are on the narrow path. When actually they are on the broad path seeing the kingdom, seeing some of those who have entered in but themselves are locked from entering. Why? They read and disbelieved. They listened and chose to disbelieve. They walk the broad path hearing and believing the lies of the one they follow. They do not know this path ends in death.

Listen too and believe the prophets I send to you. And after you believe, repent that I may pour out My blessings and favor upon you. I only have plans of good for those who listen to My Son and obey. I only have plans of good for those who read My word and obey. I only have plans of good for those who hear My prophets repenting to obey. I only have plans of good for those who listen to what the Holy Spirit is saying to the church and obeys. I only have discipline for those who think what they have until they repent that they will have it. How many are running the race on the broad path? How many are running the race on the narrow path that few find? Examine yourselves to see if your actions line up with My word. Examine yourself asking, do I have the Holy Spirit that I may hear what the Spirit is saying? Examine yourself to make sure 'your ticket is punched for the destination you hope for'. Not all is as it seems in this world that Satan runs for a while longer." Amen.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, I have been faithful in sharing with you the Lord's warnings and teachings. The messages from the Lord have changed not since August 1999 the month and year the Lord began pouring out the Holy Spirit upon me. In Jeremiah's time the Lord's message was the same. God changes not. *Jeremiah 5:30-31* ³⁰ *A wonderful and horrible thing is*

committed in the land; **31** *The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and my people love to have it so: and what will ye do in the end thereof?* (KJV) But if we repent and come out of these unholy things, we will have times of refreshment. Peter spoke of this as he preached in the Temple in **Acts 3:19-21**¹⁹ *Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away.* ²⁰ *Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord, and he will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah.* ²¹ *For he must remain in heaven until the time for the final restoration of all things, as God promised long ago through his holy prophets.* (NLT)

We must follow Peter's example and obey God and not man. We must follow the example of Jesus Christ and find and do the will of the Father in our life. We must obey the terms of the New Covenant to remain attached to the true vine being Jesus Christ. How long before we separate ourselves from the vain imaginations of man and obey God? When we obey God the Holy Ghost (Spirit) is given to us. See Acts 5:17-32. When we obey God we become sons and daughters of God through Jesus Christ calling God Abba Father.

Romans 8:15-16 ¹⁵ *For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.* ¹⁶ *The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:* (KJV) **Galatians 4:6-7** ⁶ *And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.* ⁷ *Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.* (KJV) If you are born of the Spirit following examples of the apostles and disciples in the Book of Acts, you will understand that in Romans the Spirit of adoption being received is the Holy Ghost. And in Galatians it is the Spirit of Jesus Christ. We also know that we have the Spirit of God at conception because the Spirit of God is in all living things. There are example after example in the New Testament that shows the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ) and the Holy Ghost (Spirit) working for our good and the good of the church. See 1 Corinthians 12:4-5 and you will see the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost. See Ephesians 4:1-6 and you will see the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost. See 1 Corinthians 14:28 the works of the Father. See 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 the works of the Holy Ghost. See Ephesians 4:7-11 the works of the Son Jesus Christ. If you cannot see or understand these scriptures, you are lacking spiritual understanding.

To receive full rights of the kingdom of God, we must be born of water and of the Spirit that we may enter in. Ask yourself, are you climbing over the wall trying to enter into the kingdom of God being on the broad path? As the Lord spoke and I pray that you will examine yourself to make sure 'your ticket is punched for the destination you hope for' by entering by the door of Jesus Christ the narrow path.

The Holy Spirit has directed me to enclose what He had me write in another publication that you may receive understanding of the Lords message with fear and trembling repenting to be who God wants you to be. Amen.

I end this study with what the Lord spoke to me, taught me and a comment by Smith Wigglesworth. In prayer on January 16, 2002 the Holy Spirit spoke this with great firmness in his voice **“There is only one way to be spiritual and to walk with Me in the Spirit and that is to be Baptized by the Holy Spirit. There is no other way”**. In prayer on April 29, 2003 the Holy Spirit opened my eyes to this truth—“By faith we believe and walk. By faith and walking in the Spirit, we have the power to make us Godly. Without faith and power the armor of God

will not protect us. We must be born of the Spirit to wear the armor of God. It is Spiritual armor against the spirits of darkness. To serve God in these latter days, we must be born of the Spirit. It is God's Word."

Smith Wigglesworth preached this in the book titled "The Anointing of His Spirit" from a sermon he preached at Aimee Semple McPherson's Angelus Temple in California in 1927. Wigglesworth had been Baptized by the Holy Ghost for twenty years and had preached all over the world by that day in the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit. He is quoted here—" Who has a right to the Epistles? Now is a person made a prophet or an apostle or a teacher before the baptism of the Spirit or after? I want to speak to you very definitely, and I want you to keep in mind what the Spirit shall say to us at this time. When I went to New Zealand, the power of God was very present, and he wonderfully worked miracles and wonders there. And the gift that laid hold of the whole place was the gift of tongues and interpretation. [I add this note—The gift of tongues and interpretation are two of the nine gifts of the Spirit listed in 1 Corinthians 12:7-11. This gift of tongues is given by the Holy Spirit as He decides.] It moved the whole city till the place which held thirty-five hundred people often was overcrowded, and we had two and three thousand more who could not get in.

Now when the Plymouth Brethren, who knew the Word of God, saw the grace of God upon me, they wanted to talk with me. So I scheduled a time and eighteen of them came. They began by saying, "Well, we know God is with you; it is clearly proven." (In ten days we had two thousand people saved, and fifteen hundred of those young converts sat down to breaking bread. And it was the Plymouth Brethren who served us the wine and bread.) "Now," they went on, "we want to examine the truth with you to see where things stand." I said, "All right brethren." In a moment or two they were quoting to me from Ephesians. "But," I said "beloved, you know better than anybody that the person that climbs up some other way is a thief and a robber, don't you? How many times have you preached that? Jesus is the door, and everyone entering that way shall be saved. What does it mean? Jesus is truth."

They continued quoting to me from Ephesians. "But, brethren," said I, "you have no right to Ephesians; you have no right to the epistles. The epistles are not for you. You are climbing up some other way." Without fear of contradiction, on the authority of God, I say today, there is no person in this place who has a right to the epistles until they have gone through the Acts of the Apostles and received the Holy Ghost.

The Plymouth Brethren said I could not prove it. I said, "I can prove it very easily." And I read, "For he that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understands *him*, howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries" (1 Corinthians 14:2)

"Now, brethren, tell me if you understand that." They answered no. "Simply because you have never received the Holy Ghost. Every person who received the Holy Ghost receives that gift, speaking unto God by the Spirit. The Gospels are the gospel of the kingdom. The Acts of the Apostles are where people see water baptism, sanctification, and also see the fulfilled receiving of the Holy Ghost. So the moment you pass through the Acts of the Apostles you are ready for the epistles, for the epistles are written to baptized believers.

"I will prove it another way," I said, and read Romans 8:26-27: "Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of God.*" Here is another distinct position of a person filled with the Holy Ghost. That is not the Spirit of Christ; that is the Holy Spirit. There is quite a difference between

the Spirit of Christ and the Holy Spirit. Then Smith Wigglesworth spoke in tongues and gave the interpretation: *“For the Lord himself is the chief director of all truth, for he is the way and the truth. Therefore the Spirit takes the Word, which is Christ, and reveals it unto us, for he is the life by the Word. ‘He who hears my word and believes on him that sent me has everlasting life.’ Jesus is the way, Jesus is the truth, Jesus is the life.”*

Remember our heavenly Father will give the Holy Spirit to those who ask. ***Luke 11:11-13***
11 "You fathers--if your children ask for a fish, do you give them a snake instead? 12 Or if they ask for an egg, do you give them a scorpion? Of course not! 13 If you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him." (NLT) Amen.
