The Lord said to write this day as I entered my prayer closet. What the Lord spoke is what the Holy Ghost has been revealing to my spirit over many months. The word of God says we cannot. **John 15:5-6** ⁵ *I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.* ⁶ *If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.* (KJV) Listen to what the Lord has to say from what He began speaking on November 16, 2008. When He quit speaking that day, He said wait and there is more to be added. As our Lord promised He has given me more to add days later. I pray that as you read that you humble yourself before the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost and receive this message in your heart by your spirit man and that it will not be rejected by your flesh man.

The Path of Righteousness

Who goes down the path of righteousness? What is the path of righteousness? If the righteous are barley saved, where do those claiming righteousness stand? For too long those claiming righteousness have not received the truth of My word. They have not and cannot walk down the path of righteousness. Why, because the path of righteousness is receiving and obeying the full truth of My word. They deny Me and the Father who sent Me by walking in unrighteousness having heard the parts of My word that tickles their ears. They sound righteous but by denying Me they deny the power of the Holy Ghost that could make them righteous. In their unrighteousness they heap piles of lies by the doctrines of man and his precept of righteousness. They will be shaken as I continue to shake the heavens and the earth. Repent they must of their righteousness by the precept of man. Only by humbling their hearts and asking for forgiveness of the lies they believed as truth that they may come into righteousness walking the path of righteousness.

Remember My words spoken in **Matthew 7:21-23** ²¹ *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.* ²² *Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?* ²³

And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (KJV) Since August 1999 I have had My prophet warning the churches of America to repent. The churches have not repented and My words from above will apply to those that repent not. Understand it is not the building, it is not the numbers in each church, it is not the amount of money in the church checking account it is not the missions you have, it is not who your leadership, it is not your praise and worship and it is not your sound systems and video screens that is pleasing to Me. Righteous you are not because the tree called the church produces bad fruit being works of iniquity. This fruit of unrighteousness is the result of disobeying My word not finding and doing the will of My Father.

My Church is where two or more are gathered together in My name doing as described in My word. ***1 Corinthians 14:26-40*** ²⁶ *How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.* ²⁷ *If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret.* ²⁸ *But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.* ²⁹ *Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.* ³⁰ *If any thing be revealed to another that sitteth by, let the first hold his peace.* ³¹ *For ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn, and all may be comforted.* ³² *And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.* ³³ *For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.* ³⁴ *Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.* ³⁵ *And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.* ³⁶ *What? came the word of God out from you? or came it unto you only?* ³⁷ *If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, **let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.*** ³⁸ *But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant.* ³⁹ *Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.* ⁴⁰ *Let all things be done decently and in order.* (KJV)

My Church will have unity in the body as My word describes. ***Ephesians 4:1-32*** ¹ *I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,* ² *With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;* ³ *Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.* ⁴ *There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;* ⁵ *One Lord, one faith, one baptism,* ⁶ *One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.* ⁷ *But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.* ⁸ *Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.* ⁹ *(Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth? ¹⁰ He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)* ¹¹ *And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;* ¹² *For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:* ¹³ *Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:* ¹⁴ *That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;* ¹⁵ *But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:* ¹⁶ *From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the*

body unto the edifying of itself in love. ¹⁷ This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, ¹⁸ Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: ¹⁹ Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. ²⁰ But ye have not so learned Christ; ²¹ If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: ²² That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; ²³ And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; ²⁴ And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. ²⁵ Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another. ²⁶ Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: ²⁷ Neither give place to the devil. ²⁸ Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth. ²⁹ Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. ³⁰ And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. ³¹ Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: ³² And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. (KJV)

These things produce good fruit that you may live in My light as My word states. **Ephesians 5:1-33** ¹ Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; ² And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour. ³ But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; ⁴ Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. ⁵ For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. ⁶ Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. ⁷ Be not ye therefore partakers with them. ⁸ For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light: ⁹ (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) ¹⁰ Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord. ¹¹ And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. ¹² For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret. ¹³ But all things that are reprovèd are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light. ¹⁴ Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light. ¹⁵ See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, ¹⁶ Redeeming the time, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ **Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is.** ¹⁸ **And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;** ¹⁹ Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; ²⁰ Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; ²¹ Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God. ²² Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. ²³ For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. ²⁴ Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; ²⁶ That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and

without blemish. ²⁸ So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. ²⁹ For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church: ³⁰ For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. ³¹ For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. ³² This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church. ³³ Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband. (KJV) This is the path of righteousness. Those who obey My word walk that path.

How can there be righteousness when the foundation of My word has been twisted, distorted, and yes, even removed in the churches. The result is greed, lust, larceny, idolatry, witchcraft, divorce, adultery, abortions, homosexuality, pornography, hate, envy, murder fighting, deception, malicious behavior, and gossip in churches, business and government. Man has sinned in his duties of home and woman has become the head of the household causing woman to sin against My word. Then that same woman has elevated herself to positions of power in churches, business and government. Corruption is the disease being bad fruit. Repentance is the cure if My word is obeyed with Me as the foundation. Generation after generation My foundation has been chipped away that allows the flesh of man to rule and make rules that please the flesh of man being unrighteousness. An example is that a man divorces his wife or a woman divorces her husband with church leadership sitting the example of divorce. I said in *Mark 10:11-12* ¹¹ *And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committeth adultery against her. ¹² And if a woman shall put away her husband, and be married to another, she committeth adultery.* (KJV) and in *Mark 10:6-9* ⁶ *But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. ⁷ For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; ⁸ And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh. ⁹ What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.* (KJV) By the rules made in the flesh of man called doctrines My word has been made none effect by the traditions of the man of flesh. Disorder and chaos follows that man and woman in all their lives having unrighteousness.

In judgment I will restore righteousness. With righteousness My word will be understood and obeyed. With righteousness My Church will be a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. (Ephesians 5:27) With righteousness My Church will be redeemed from all iniquity, and purify unto itself to be a peculiar people, zealous of good works. (Titus 2:14) With righteousness My Church will be holy as My Father is holy. With righteousness My Church is My body of My flesh and My bones being a light unto the world hated without cause. Will you be part of that body My Church? Repent and ask for forgiveness in My name and My Father will forgive you from any sin except the sin of blasphemy against the Holy Ghost. Repent and come out of the churches of the flesh of man to be My Church hidden in the wilderness being this evil world of corruption. This wilderness will come to naught. My Church hidden in this wilderness will shine brighter than ten thousand suns in the days to come.

I AM. To be My body, My Church, you must repent of unrighteousness. Then with righteousness, you must put your hand to the plow bearing your cross not looking back letting the dead bury their dead. You will have life being a light of Me for Me and by Me who is the truth that must be obeyed. With obedience you will hear what the Spirit is saying to you being part of the body of My Church hidden in the wilderness.

Let those who will repent do so to be part of My body. Let those who are unrighteousness without repentance continue so to be gathered and burned. Only those and I repeat ONLY THOSE who find and walk the narrow path of righteousness will be with Me when the last trump is sounded. The unrighteousness ones claiming of doing good works in My name will not be with Me. It is spoken in My word. Amen.

The desire of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is that we be mature in our knowing the word of God and applying that word in our lives. This is what the writer of Hebrews was writing about in **Hebrews 6:1-3** ¹ *Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,* ² *with instruction about ablutions, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.* ³ *And this we will do if God permits.* (RSV) Are we mature when we disregard the teachings and commands from Jesus Christ? Are we mature when we disregard some of the things Paul wrote in the epistles? Are we mature when we twist the word of God making another Christ and worshipping that Christ? The answer is no. We sin against Christ and the kingdom of God walking in unrighteousness. Our knowledge and wisdom comes from our flesh man and we think we are righteous. God will not permit us to leave the principles of the doctrine of Christ to become mature in our understanding. God will chastise us because we claim Christ being in unrighteousness that we may repent to walk in righteousness.

Jesus Christ walked in righteousness doing the will of His Father. We are in unrighteousness if we skip over some of the commands of Jesus Christ and picking to do the commands we choose. Paul was righteousness and we are unrighteousness if we say Paul was full of himself. Consequently we have come to disregard some of the things Paul wrote about. Paul was obeying the commands of Jesus Christ remaining faithful to what Jesus Christ opened his mind to on the road to Damascus and as he lived his life in the spirit and not the flesh. We are sinning because of our own thinking and our own actions. The word of God proves our sin. Look at the last part of **1 Corinthians 14** ³⁷ *If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.*

We Christians must be able to handle the two edged sword of the word of God with maturity allowing us to cut deep into our innermost thoughts and desires. Then we will examine ourselves to see if our faith is genuine by testing our actions and thoughts against the word of God. It our responsibility to never oppose the truth of the word of God but to stand for the truth at all times. We must be born of the Spirit as Jesus Christ commanded to be able to walk in communion of the Holy Ghost as Paul wrote and to pray in the Holy Ghost building up our most holy faith that Jude wrote.

With the Holy Ghost as our teacher we will handle the two edged sword being the word of God with maturity. For example I was thinking about **1 Corinthians 14** ³⁷ from above and the Lord reminded me that Paul discussed things that were customs or traditions, or doctrines that he applied to the church. As such these are options that we can or cannot do without disobedience to the word of God. This was about instructions for public worship of keeping the ordinances as Paul delivered them to the church 1 Corinthians chapter 11. Let us look at **1 Corinthians 11:13-16** ¹³ *What do you think about this? Is it right for a woman to pray to God in public without covering her head?* ¹⁴ *Isn't it obvious that it's disgraceful for a man to have long hair?* ¹⁵ *And isn't it obvious that long hair is a woman's pride and joy? For it has been given to her as a covering.* ¹⁶ *But if anyone wants to argue about this, all I can say is that we have no other*

custom than this, and all the churches of God feel the same way about it. (NLT) This subject of a woman praying in public without a covering or a man should not have long hair is a custom set by the churches and Paul agreed with that custom. This was not a commandment of the Lord.

I ask the same questions that our Lord and Savior asked. "Who goes down the path of righteousness? What is the path of righteousness?" I answer these questions by quoting what our Lord and Savior stated. "The path of righteousness is receiving and obeying the full truth of My word." We must always remember what Jesus said in Matthew 7:22 about that we prophesied in His name, cast out devils in His name and done many wonderful works in His name. This is the path of unrighteousness that is described twice in Proverbs. **Proverbs 14:12** *There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death.* (NLT) **Proverbs 16: 25** *There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death.* (NLT) If we walk this path thinking we will have salvation on the day of Jesus Christ's return, we will hear on that day "*And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.*"

Only Christians that obey the word of God in the Spirit and not the flesh can walk the path of righteousness. Therefore we must fear the Lord and examine ourselves that we may obey the full truth of the word of God to do the will of the Father. Meditate on these verses from the word of God. **Hebrews 5:8-9** ⁸ *Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;* ⁹ *And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;* (KJV). **Romans 2:8** *But he will pour out his anger and wrath on those who live for themselves, who refuse to obey the truth and practice evil deeds.* (NLT) **1 Peter 4:17** *For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?* (KJV) **1 John 2:3-5** ³ *And how can we be sure that we belong to him? By obeying his commandments.* ⁴ *If someone says, "I belong to God," but doesn't obey God's commandments, that person is a liar and does not live in the truth.* ⁵ *But those who obey God's word really do love him. That is the way to know whether or not we live in him.* (NLT) **Acts 5:29-32**²⁹ *Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.* ³⁰ *The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.* ³¹ *Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.* ³² *And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.* (KJV) We as Christians must obey the word of God not according to the doctrines of a church. We must obey the word of God according to the teachings of the Holy Ghost. The word of God is God's truth of righteousness. God is not a liar but we lie if we disobey God's truth claiming righteousness. Amen.
