If Christians don't have a Spirit of decrement and are listening to slanted speech of words that sound valid, they will be led astray. Psalm 75 that Asaph wrote, he was talking about the prosperity of the wicked, their painless life, their pride, and their words that go about the earth. In **Psalm 73:10** *And so the people are dismayed and confused, drinking in all their words.* (NLT) We must be cautious and pray for the gift of discernment that the Holy Spirit may teach us what is true and what is false.

Remember **Proverbs 18:21** *Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.* (KJV) We must beware of what we speak as well as what we hear. In today's modern society there are many forms of sound that can assault us 24 hrs. a day if we let it. If we tune into that sound in our car, in our home and doing outside chores, will we miss God who said above "Repent and be silent that you may hear what I want you to do?"

Above all Christians must heed the words of Solomon in **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14** **13** *Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. 14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.* (KJV)

Christians must fear God not by the precepts of man.
