From the Holy Spirit in prayer this day. I titled it “Who Are The Workers Of Iniquity?”

1. Those seeking God’s hand and not his face, become spoiled brats, for God is faithful to his Word when prayers are prayed in faith. These are works of iniquity for they know not the face of God.

2. Many are called to the mountain of God to be trained and used by God. Many do not wait for their training to be completed by the Holy Ghost and go out prematurely in disobedience to God. This is rebellion and rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft and anointing becomes false and they are deceived by the prince of this world in thinking they are doing the work of God. These are works of iniquity because of disobedience and rebellion.

3. Puzzle pieces are likened to God’s servants he has called. As a puzzle piece only fits in one area of the puzzle, that servant has an area of operation for his service to God. Some puzzle pieces are like a master key and can fit anywhere. Other puzzle pieces have very small and defined areas to function for God. If these servants operate in areas not authorized, they are workers of iniquity.

4. Only by seeking God’s face can we as his servants be without iniquity for we hear the Spirit and obey as we hear from God in our prayer closet. There are no shortcuts in serving God. Taking shortcuts leads to iniquity.

5. Impatience and disobedience is rebellion and with these traits in trying to serve God, that servant is incomplete, incompetent, and incompatible with the Kingdom of God and cannot complete the plans God has for his life for he works iniquity in the site of God.

*1 Samuel 15:23 23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the*

*word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king. (KJV)*  
**Matthew 7:21-23** ***21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. **22** Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? **23** And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (KJV)*
