

The Church Jesus Is Coming For

To my brothers and sisters in Christ who profess Jesus Christ as your King of kings and Lord of lords that have been Christians for a long time. Now is the time we must move on to further understanding in these latter days of the last days. We must become fully prepared to teach other Christians old and new to be the church Jesus is coming for. It will be a church without spot or wrinkle that is holy and without blemish; a church that He has sanctified and cleansed with the washing of water (washed by baptism) by His Word.

The church Jesus is coming for will not be what we see today in the world called denominational churches. It will be a church that has stopped going over the basics of Christianity again and again. It will be a church that knows the importance of turning away from evil deeds and placing our faith in God. It will be a church that doesn't need further instructions about baptisms (born of water and born of the Spirit), the laying on of hands (for healing, baptism of the Holy Spirit, and the gifts of the Spirit), and the resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment. It will be a church that has the gifts that Jesus gave to it (the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and the teachers). It will be a church that operates in the nine gifts of the Spirit (word of wisdom, word of knowledge, faith, healing, working of miracles, prophecy, discerning of the spirits, divers kinds of tongues, and interpretation of tongues). It will be a church in truth, love, unity of one accord, unity in faith with the knowledge of God's Son. It will be a mature church full grown in the Lord, measuring up to the full stature of Christ. Under Christ's direction the church, the body of believers, will be fitted together perfectly with each part of the body doing its special work helping the other parts of the body to grow into maturity so that the whole body is healthy and growing full of love. It will be a church that has on the whole armor of God standing firm against all strategies and tricks of the Devil. It will be a church that wrestles or fights not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, rulers of darkness of this world and spiritual wickedness in high places or heavenly realms. It will be a church that prays at all times and on every occasion in the power of the Holy Spirit being alert and persistent in their prayers for all Christians everywhere. It will be a church that will do the same works that Jesus did and greater works.

I ask you, the reader, have you seen or been in such a church as described above? I myself have not, but the Lord said He is setting His house in order before he comes and He is coming for just such a church. Has the Lord called you to prepare and help make His Church ready? Are you lacking in knowledge of what the Church Jesus is coming for needs to be? If so, then this teaching is for you.

With the help of the Holy Spirit, in this study I will present a picture of the Church Jesus Christ died on the cross for. This study comes from what the Holy Spirit spoke to me on January 6, 2002 at 2:00 pm. From what the Lord spoke that day, the Spirit has guided me to break it down part by part with scripture to present what the church Jesus is coming for is to be like according to the Word of God and not according to man's plans. These parts will be labeled A, B, C and etc. In some sections the scripture explains and gives witness to what the Holy Spirit spoke with no further comment. In other sections I will add a brief explanation in addition to the scripture. In this teaching you will find some scripture repeated in different sections. Remember the Word of God has many truths and the same scripture can apply to those different truths. I begin with what the Lord spoke that day.

“Man's ways are not in alignment with My ways or My thoughts. Man has chosen his way, the low way (in the flesh) to worship me. Man does not bring Me honor when he worships in the flesh. Honor comes only when man worships Me in the spirit. My Word, man still refuses to obey. Disobedience of My Word is of the antichrist that brings out the carnally in man. With blind eyes and deaf ears he marches onward worshipping Me in the flesh.

I am moving in the Spirit. I have chosen, trained and I am sending forth My Heoieta's to birth My church. My church will be a living organism as the human body is alive with all parts working together. My church will work together in the gifts of the spirit with governmental oversight. My church will be militant and victorious having the keys of the Kingdom binding and loosing, connected with heaven and united. My church will be one universal church in various localities. My church will be in one accord, one heart, one mind, with unity in the name of God, with unity in the Word of God, unity in the glory of God, unity in the love of God. My church will be a glorious church. My church will be in My perfect will and not in My permitted will. My church is not a material building, a denomination, a nationalistic enterprise, or Judaism extended, is not the kingdom of God and not parenthetical. My church is of My eternal purpose. I set My church in order by blessings and judgments before I come. I tarry not, I come.”

In this section we will break down what the Lord spoke by adding scripture to paint a picture of the church (the body of Christ) that Jesus is coming for. ***Ephesians 5:27 27** That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. (KJV)*

(A) “Man's ways are not in alignment with My ways or My thoughts. Man has chosen his way, the low way to worship me. Man does not bring Me honor when he worships in the flesh. Honor comes only when man worships Me in the spirit. My Word man still refuses to obey. Disobedience of My Word is of the

antichrist that brings out the carnally in man. With blind eyes and deaf ears he marches onward worshipping Me in the flesh.”

We must come into the truth of the Word and obey the Word to worship God in the spirit. These are the teachings and commands Jesus give to his disciples to teach and to do. **John 4:23-24** ²³ *But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.* ²⁴ *God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.* (KJV) **John 3:3-6** ³ *Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.* ⁴ *Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?* ⁵ *Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.* ⁶ *That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.* ⁷ *Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.* (KJV)

(B) “I am moving in the Spirit. I have chosen, trained and I am sending forth My Heoieta’s to birth My church.” God changes not. **Malachi 3:6-7** ⁶ *"I am the LORD, and I do not change. That is why you descendants of Jacob are not already completely destroyed.* ⁷ *Ever since the days of your ancestors, you have scorned my laws and failed to obey them. Now return to me, and I will return to you," says the LORD Almighty. "But you ask, 'How can we return when we have never gone away?'"* (NLT) He is preparing the remnant who listened when He called. God is training them to be the leaders in the church Jesus is preparing before he comes. The Lord spoke this to me in prayer on December 4, 2001. “I am building My church out of the ashes of the existing churches. It will be on My foundation with all corners connected with no gaps or divisions. I will pour out My Spirit upon it for revival. My army will be made ready.”

(C) “**My church will be a living organism as the human body is alive with all parts working together.**” **1 Corinthians 12:12** ¹² *For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.* (KJV) All believers are members of the Body of Christ, human worth. The human body is an exquisite organism. Scientists cannot duplicate it or even fully understand it. It is a synthesis of many parts all working together in a comprehensive whole. What affects one part of the body affects the whole. Each member of the body relates to and depends upon other parts of the body. Each contributes to the welfare of the entire body. So are all believers as members of the body of Christ. We should function in Christ’s body as the parts of

the human body function in it. The amputation of a limb handicaps the entire body. There is no Christian brother whom we **do not** need.

(D) **“My church will work together in the gifts of the spirit with governmental oversight.”** *1 Corinthians 12: 4* Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same **Spirit**. *5* And there are differences of administrations, but the same **Lord**. *6* And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same **God** which worketh all in all. *7* But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. *8* For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; *9* To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; *10* To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: *11* But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. (KJV) **Ephesians 4: 11** And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; *12* For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: *13* Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: *14* That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; *15* But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: (KJV)

(E) **“My church will be militant and victorious having the keys of the Kingdom binding and loosing, connected with heaven and united.”**

“My church will be militant and victorious”—*Ephesians 6: 11* Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies and tricks of the Devil. *12* For we are not fighting against people made of flesh and blood, but against the evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against those mighty powers of darkness who rule this world, and against wicked spirits in the heavenly realms. *13* Use every piece of God's armor to resist the enemy in the time of evil, so that after the battle you will still be standing firm. *14* Stand your ground, putting on the sturdy belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. *15* For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News, so that you will be fully prepared. *16* In every battle you will need faith as your shield to stop the fiery arrows aimed at you by Satan. *17* Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. *18* Pray at all times

and on every occasion in the power of the Holy Spirit. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all Christians everywhere. (NLT) Our weapons for warfare are not carnal, but through God. The armour of God is needed for battle as our Kingdom is not of this world system, hence we do not fight physically but spiritually with prayer. The Church is to march and storm the forts of darkness in the Spirit. Also see John 18:36, Revelation 12:10-11, Acts 12:10, Psalm 9:13, Isaiah 38:10, Matthew 7:13, Genesis 28:17 and Isaiah 26:2 for further study.

“Having the Keys of the Kingdom” *Matthew 16: 19* And I will give unto thee **the keys of the kingdom** of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. (KJV) *Luke 11: 52* Woe unto you, lawyers! for ye have taken away **the key of knowledge**: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered. (KJV) *Revelation 3: 7* And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath **the key of David**, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth; (KJV) AND *Isaiah 22:* And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah. *22* And **the key of the house of David** will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open. (KJV) *Revelation 1: 18* I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have **the keys of hell and of death**. (KJV) *Revelation 9: 1* And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given **the key of the bottomless pit**. (KJV) AND *Revelation 20: 1* And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having **the key of the bottomless pit** and a great chain in his hand. (KJV) Keys of the Kingdom are significant of power and authority. The Church Jesus is coming for will know how to use the keys to be victorious in spiritual warfare.

“Binding” *Matthew 12: 29* Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first **bind** the strong man? and then he will spoil his house. (KJV) (KJV) The Church is to bind the strong man, then spoil his house by praying with the full armor of God on. *Matthew 18: 15* Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother. *16* But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. *17* And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican. *18* Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall **bind** on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth

shall be loosed in heaven. (KJV) In the matter of church discipline, a brother or sister that is sinning is bound and removed from the church as Paul taught in 1 Corinthians 5:3-5. **Revelation 20: 2** *And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,* (KJV) **2 Timothy 2: 9** *Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound.* (KJV) The Word of God cannot be bound. The Church Jesus is coming will use the power and authority given by Jesus Christ to bind those who oppose God's will in heaven, on the earth and under the earth.

“Loosing” **Luke 13: 16** *And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?* (KJV) AND **John 11:43** *And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.* **44** *And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, *Loose him, and let him go.** (KJV) **Mark 7: 35** *And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.* (KJV) **Psalm 102: 20** *To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death;* (KJV) **Hebrews 6: 2** *You don't need further instruction about baptisms, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead* [Satan binds by death and the Church is to loosen those from death as Jesus loosed Lazarus from death and Jairus' 12 year old daughter from death in Luke 9:54], *and eternal judgment.* (NLT) Satan binds his captives by disease and sin. The Church Jesus is coming for is called to loose those captives and bind the powers of Satan that bind the world by the authority given by Jesus Christ and by the power given by the Holy Spirit.

“Connected with heaven” **Matthew 28: 19** *Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.* **20** *Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”* (NLT) The Church on earth is to be one with the Lord in heaven. All power is His in heaven and earth and is given to the Church to do the works Jesus did and greater works. **Mark 16: 15** *And then he told them, “Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone, everywhere.* **16** *Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be condemned.* **17** *These signs will accompany those who believe: They will cast out demons in my name, and they will speak new languages.* **18** *They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick and heal them.”* **19** *When the Lord Jesus had finished talking with them, he was taken up into heaven and sat down in the place*

of honor at God's right hand. **20** And the disciples went everywhere and preached, and the Lord worked with them, confirming what they said by many miraculous signs. (NLT) The disciples waited and obeyed and went forth after Pentecost preaching. The Lord in heaven worked with them confirming the Word with signs following. This is still the job of the Church today and there still should be signs following. **Matthew 6: 10** *Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.* (KJV) The will of God is to be done through the Church, the body of Christ.

“United” **John 17: 11** *Now I am departing the world; I am leaving them behind and coming to you. Holy Father, keep them and care for them--all those you have given me--so that they will be united just as we are. **21** My prayer for all of them is that they will be one, just as you and I are one, Father--that just as you are in me and I am in you, so they will be in us, and the world will believe you sent me.*

22 *"I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are--*

23 *I in them and you in me, all being perfected into one. Then the world will know that you sent me and will understand that you love them as much as you love me.*(NLT) The Lord knew that divisions would come among Christians and thus prayed that the world might see a united Church, a Church at unity in and with itself. Unity is one of the most powerful forces in earth, whether for good or evil. Before the Lord Jesus comes again, His church will be in order according to His Word and the world will see His church working in unity of one accord.

(F) “My church will be one Universal Church in various localities. My church will be in one accord, one heart, one mind with unity in the name of God, with unity in the Word of God, unity in the glory of God, unity in the love of God.”

“One Universal Church in various localities” **Matthew 16: 18** *And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.* (KJV) **Acts 2: 47** *Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.* (KJV) Also see Acts 5:11, Acts 8:3, Acts 8:1-3, Acts 9:31, Acts 20:17, Ephesians 5:25-27, and Ephesians 1:22. In all of these scriptures the word Church is singular and speaks of One Universal Church. When the word “Churches” is used it speaks of the One Church in various locations. Look at how Jesus spoke about churches in **Revelation 1: 11** *Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.* (KJV) The only reason for distinctions in the Church is a geographical

setting, nothing else. The Universal Church is not a building or denomination, but the body of Christ assembled together doing the works of Christ and greater works and to worship God in the Spirit. As a believer you should be able to go to any Church meeting anywhere in the world and see Christ as the Head and the Holy Spirit gifts working with the body doing the works of Jesus and greater works. The only difference might be the language being spoken depending on the country you are in.

“One accord, one heart, one mind” *Acts 1: 14* *These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.-- Acts 4: 32* *And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul.--Philippians 1: 27* *Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;* (KJV). The Early Church was of one accord, one heart and one mind obeying the teachings of Christ through the apostles and prophets. In being of one heart, one mind and one accord, the early Church turned the world upside down by the power of the Holy Spirit. The Church Jesus is coming for will do even greater works. There the Lord commanded the blessing-- *Psalms 33: 1* *Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwelt together in unity!* *2* *It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments;* *3* *As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, even life for evermore.* (KJV)

“Unity in the name of God” *John 17: 6* *"I have told these men about you. They were in the world, but then you gave them to me. Actually, they were always yours, and you gave them to me; and they have kept your word. 11* *Now I am departing the world; I am leaving them behind and coming to you. Holy Father, keep them and care for them--all those you have given me--so that they will be united just as we are.* *12* *During my time here, I have kept them safe. I guarded them so that not one was lost, except the one headed for destruction, as the Scriptures foretold.* (NLT) We must be in unity in the name of God. Denominational names and sectarian names divide the Church causing enmity among brothers and sisters. There can only be unity in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, the head of the Church. *Ephesians 3: 14* *For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15* *Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,* (KJV). We must be in unity with God to be in his family in heaven or on earth.

“Unity in the Word of God” *John 17: 6* *"I have told these men about you. They were in the world, but then you gave them to me. Actually, they were always*

yours, and you gave them to me; and they have kept your word. ⁷ Now they know that everything I have is a gift from you, ⁸ for I have passed on to them the words you gave me; and they accepted them and know that I came from you, and they believe you sent me. ¹⁴ I have given them your word. And the world hates them because they do not belong to the world, just as I do not. ¹⁷ Make them pure and holy by teaching them your words of truth. ¹⁹ And I give myself entirely to you so they also might be entirely yours. ²⁰ "I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me because of their testimony. (NLT) With unity in the Word of God there is only one truth. To have unity of the faith by the Word and the revelations of God; only the Holy Spirit can bring unity in the Word of God so that divisions within the body cease to exist. Doctrinal divisions do not exist in the Godhead and will not exist in the Church that Jesus Christ is the head of.

“Unity in the glory of God” *John 17: 2* For you have given him authority over everyone in all the earth. He gives eternal life to each one you have given him. ⁴ I brought glory to you here on earth by doing everything you told me to do. ⁵ And now, Father, bring me into the glory we shared before the world began. ¹⁰ And all of them, since they are mine, belong to you; and you have given them back to me, so they are my glory! ²² "I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are-- ²⁴ Father, I want these whom you've given me to be with me, so they can see my glory. You gave me the glory because you loved me even before the world began! (NLT) We are one in His glory, the glory of God and Christ. Not the glory of men, or of the movement of a denomination, but the glory of Christ. *Ephesians 3: 21* Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen. (KJV) Only in unity with Christ will there be glory in the Church. Christ will be the head of His Church. There will be no doctrines or traditions of man, because the Holy Spirit will be the teacher and not man.

“Unity in love of God” *John 17: 23* I in them and you in me, all being perfected into one. Then the world will know that you sent me and will understand that you love them as much as you love me. ²⁴ Father, I want these whom you've given me to be with me, so they can see my glory. You gave me the glory because you loved me even before the world began! ²⁶ And I have revealed you to them and will keep on revealing you. I will do this so that your love for me may be in them and I in them." (NLT) God is love which is the very nature of the Godhead. *John 3: 16* For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (KJV) Look at these scriptures below in John 17. Here we have the very secret and power of unity, the

glory of unity, the perfection of unity, **John 17: 21** *My prayer for all of them is that they will be one, just as you and I are one, Father--that just as you are in me and I am in you, so they will be in us, and the world will believe you sent me.* **22** *"I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are--* **23** *I in them and you in me, all being perfected into one. Then the world will know that you sent me and will understand that you love them as much as you love me.* (NLT) The Lord has purposed this kind of Church and nothing in heaven or on the earth or under the earth will frustrate this purpose. **There will be a Church that will be "one as we are one". His prayer will be answered. Jesus will have His Church and it will be one with Him as He is one with the Father before he comes.**

(G) **"My church will be a glorious church. My church will be in My perfect will and not in My permitted will."** *Isaiah 55: 9* *For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.* **10** *For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: **11** So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.* (KJV) Jesus will have a glorious Church, clothed with glory and bringing glory to Himself; a sanctified Church that is holy being born of water and of the Spirit, separated unto the Lord; a cleansed Church, by the washing of water by the Word; a holy Church, separated from sin by intimacy with Christ in prayer closets; a Church like Christ so that He can be united to His body and not have an unequal yoke in this union of the Head and body. The word has gone forth out of the mouth of the Lord and the zeal of the Lord of Hosts will perform it. This is the kind of Church He will have. God has permitted denominations through our church history, but this is not His perfect will. He permitted them, but as His Church is established in these latter days it will rise to the level of His perfect will. Then all other churches in His permissive will fade away.

Two prophecies spoken to me from the Holy Spirit confirm this—September 16, 2000 **"The churches are not a light unto the world, but a light of the world. They have compromised My Word, for they fear the world and not Me. Woe unto them, for their time is short and will be no more. The harvest will remove the wheat and the tares will be judged. Many have been misled, have become bound by lies and in their hearts they know they are lacking spiritually. This is my wheat. The tares will deny My Spirit, My Power, and My Word forever and ever and believe the lies and go to Hell with their hardened hearts of unbelief.**

My wheat will be watered and produce the fruit of final harvest of the end of the age. The end will come soon for I am accelerating time and the power of My Spirit upon this world. For I must, before man destroys My loved ones, because man loves the world and not Me. I am God and My Word reigns and no man can deny My Word. My Word is coming in power and glory.”

November 10, 2000—“As this nation is divided between morality and immorality, I will divide the churches, separating the sheep from the goats. I will lead the sheep to graze in my pasture to reach maturity with complete nourishment. A time of preparation is upon you.”

(H) “My Church is not a material building, a denomination, a nationalistic enterprise, or Judaism extended, is not the kingdom of God and not parenthetical.”

“**Not a material building**” *Acts 2: 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. Acts 5: 11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things. Acts 8 11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things. Acts 12 1 Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church. 2 And he killed James the brother of John with the sword. 3 And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.) 4 And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people. 5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. Acts 18: 22 And when he had landed at Caesarea, and gone up, and saluted the church, he went down to Antioch. (KJV)* The language used of the Church in Acts could not be applied to a material building. It represents the body of believers that meet together to worship and praise the Lord, they are the Church and not the building they meet in.

“**Not a denomination**” *1 Corinthians 3: 1 Dear brothers and sisters, when I was with you I couldn't talk to you as I would to mature Christians. I had to talk as though you belonged to this world or as though you were infants in the Christian life. 2 I had to feed you with milk and not with solid food, because you couldn't handle anything stronger. And you still aren't ready, 3 for you are still controlled by your own sinful desires. You are jealous of one another and quarrel with each other. Doesn't that prove you are controlled by your own desires? You are acting like people who don't belong to the Lord. 4 When one of you says, "I am a follower of Paul," and another says, "I prefer Apollos," aren't you acting like those who are not Christians? 5 Who is Apollos, and who is Paul, that we*

should be the cause of such quarrels? Why, we're only servants. Through us God caused you to believe. Each of us did the work the Lord gave us. (NLT) The Church is not a denomination, organization or sect. The numerous Churches, with their prefix names, all claiming to be the Lord's Church are not necessarily His Church. Christ said he would build HIS CHURCH according to His Word and the gates of Hell shall not prevail against it. The various denominational churches today, in many cases, have shut their doors to the Holy Spirit with Christ as the head of the church with their traditions, doctrines and programs; consequently the gates of Hell are banging on their doors. Denominationalism is contrary to the Scriptures. Denominations are the evidence of our carnality and divisions. This divided condition of churches and Christians are indeed sinful. **On December 4, 2001 the Holy Spirit said record**—"I tell you to write this today. It has started, the judgment of all churches. It will be gentle and increase in intensity each day. All churches and ministries will know it is I, The Lord God Almighty. They will see My power working. They will know they are in sin because of their luke warmness. This morning when you went out there was the smell of spring in the air and that means change from death to life. I am bringing change to the churches. They will change one of two ways. To become My church for this end time or they will die. They will change to life or death, for as they are now they are worthless to Me. It has started this day. Watch, listen and see. I prepare, for I tarry not, I come."

"Not a nationalistic enterprise" Colossians 3: 9-11 **9** *Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;* **10** *And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:* **11** **Where there is neither** *Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.* (KJV) **Galatians 6:15** **15** **For in Christ Jesus neither** *circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.* (KJV) National distinctions cease to exist "in Christ", where there is neither Jew nor Greek, bond nor free, male or female, but all one "in Christ." The Church is God's "new ethic" in the human race. Nationalities, color, the language we speak or genealogy ceases to exist when we are truly one "in Christ".

"Not Judaism extended" Matthew 9: 16 *And who would patch an old garment with unshrunk cloth? For the patch shrinks and pulls away from the old cloth, leaving an even bigger hole than before.* **17** *And no one puts new wine into old wineskins. The old skins would burst from the pressure, spilling the wine and ruining the skins. New wine must be stored in new wineskins. That way both the wine and the wineskins are preserved.* (NLT) **2 Corinthians 6:16** **16** *And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living*

God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. (KJV) **Hebrews 8:13** ¹³ **When God speaks of a new covenant, it means he has made the first one obsolete.** It is now out of date and ready to be put aside. (NLT) Christianity is “the new wine” of the New Covenant placed in ‘new wineskin’. This is The New Testament Church. We are to be the new garment, the new cloth filled with the Spirit of Christ as the head and with the Holy Spirit as our teacher. We are the new temple of the living God. We may say that Christianity was born out of Judaism as ‘the mother’. But it is still the new child of promise and is not as the mother. Things of the Old Covenant were abolished at the cross and cannot be brought into New Testament Christianity or the New Testament Church. It is a ‘new man’ born of water and of the Spirit.

“Not the Kingdom of God” The Kingdom and the Church have many common goals, but the Kingdom is larger than the Church. The Kingdom includes all of God’s creations which are the whole universe, the angelic hosts, as well as Old Testament saints, and the New Testament saints. The Church is confined to the believers of this present age on earth until Jesus comes again for His Church. The Church is connected with the Kingdom of God through Jesus Christ the head and the Holy Spirit as teacher, comforter, and revealer.

“Not parenthetical” **Ephesians 3: 3** *As I briefly mentioned earlier in this letter, God himself revealed his secret plan to me. 4 As you read what I have written, you will understand what I know about this plan regarding Christ. 5 **God did not reveal it to previous generations, but now he has revealed it by the Holy Spirit to his holy apostles and prophets.** 6 And this is the secret plan: The Gentiles have an equal share with the Jews in all the riches inherited by God's children. Both groups have believed the Good News, and both are part of the same body and enjoy together the promise of blessings through Christ Jesus. 7 By God's special favor and mighty power, I have been given the wonderful privilege of serving him by spreading this Good News.* (NLT) **2 Corinthians 3:11** ¹¹ **So if the old covenant, which has been set aside, was full of glory, then the new covenant, which remains forever, has far greater glory.** (NLT) The Church is NOT a parenthetical (for an interlude or interval of time) plan of God but was and is the **eternal purpose** of God. Under the new covenant there is only one way to God and that is through Jesus Christ. That includes all races on this earth including both Jews and Gentiles. All are lost until they come into Christ. God has no favorites when He judges.

(I) “My church is of **My eternal purpose.**” **Acts 15: 18** *Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.* (KJV) “I set My church in order by blessings and judgments before I come. I tarry not, I come.” Remember

the word Church means believers assembled together and not a building.

I know many are praying for a great end time revival. But what is revival? Here is what Webster's defines as revival. (1) an act or instance of reviving: the state of being revived: as a) renewed attention to or interest in something b) a new presentation or publication of something old c) (c1) a period of renewed religious interest (c2) an often highly emotional evangelistic meeting or series of meetings.

To be revived in something, we must first experience something in our lives that we have never experienced before. Then loose interest in that experience by being drawn to other things in our lives. At some point we wish for or pray for that experience to occur in our lives again.

I ask you, how can the denominational churches in American have revival when they have never obeyed the complete teachings of Jesus Christ? When they have never been born again of the Spirit or operated in the gifts of the Spirit, or experienced the powers of the world to come in this world, or are believers in Christ with these signs following. *Mark 16:17-18* **17** *And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.* (KJV) How many churches have come into perfection the writer of Hebrews spoke of? *Hebrews 6:1-3* **1** *Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, 2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. 3 And this will we do, if God permit.* (KJV) How many Christians today are walking in such maturity and perfection that if they fall away from God cannot come into repentance again? *Hebrews 6:4-6* **4** *For it is impossible to restore to repentance those who were once enlightened--those who have experienced the good things of heaven and shared in the Holy Spirit, 5 who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the power of the age to come-- 6 and who then turn away from God. It is impossible to bring such people to repentance again because they are nailing the Son of God to the cross again by rejecting him, holding him up to public shame.* (NLT) Is not what the denominational churches today call a revival, just highly emotional evangelistic meeting or series of meetings? Are we worshipping in the flesh and not in the Spirit? Do we become disappointed after we leave such meetings and the human emotions subside? If we cannot have revival according to the definition of revival, what has to occur to have revival?

No, Jesus does not have His Church today according to His Word. But as we read in this study what the Holy Spirit spoke—"I am building My Church out of the ashes of the existing current churches. It will be on My foundation with all

corners connected with no gaps or divisions. I will pour out My Spirit on it for revival. My army will be made ready.” As Jesus Christ builds his Church, it will be brought to maturity according to His Word as this study has taught. His Church (the body of believers) will be walking in the Spirit as they did at Pentecost. His Church will be a mature Church doing His works and greater works. The Church Jesus Christ is going to have will not be in need of revival. It will be complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power. The true Church of Jesus will be alive in the Spirit, walking in the Spirit, praying in the Spirit, and operating in the gifts of the Spirit. His Church will bring a Spiritual awaking to those who will listen and obey. Is this revival? No, it will be a new thing and not revival because many Christians will be experiencing the power of God for the first time in their lives by coming into the truth of God’s Word. **John 14:12-15** **12** *"The truth is, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.* **13** *You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, because the work of the Son brings glory to the Father.* **14** *Yes, ask anything in my name, and I will do it!* **15** ***"If you love me, obey my commandments.*** (NLT)

Brothers and sisters the status quo is about to change. God is judging His house and setting things in order. Jesus Christ will have His Church as He prayed in John 17. Are we willing to change and come into the truth of the Word and obey the commands of Jesus in these judgments that God is releasing upon this nation? Are we going to be a sheep or a goat? It is our choice. God gives us all a free will to chose. Who will we be serving in the days, months and years ahead? I pray that you seek God and be part of His Church in these latter days of the last days and that you will stand by faith and be an overcomer. Jesus is our teacher and our example to follow. May God bless you and let the Holy Spirit guide you as you seek and come into the truth of the Word of God.

In closing I share with you what the Holy Spirit spoke to me in prayer April 04, 2003. “A divided house cannot stand. A compromised house cannot stand. A house without spiritual authority cannot stand. A house that is in rebellion cannot stand. A house that is luke warm cannot stand.

Out of the houses that cannot stand , I will harvest for My house. My house will be a house of prayer with Spiritual authority in unity, in truth, and in love. My house will stand being overcomers until the end. My house will be mature house loving their lives not unto death. My house will suffer the wrath of the world for My names sake. My house will be made ready before I come. My house will be built in time of judgment and chaos that is being loosened upon this nation.

Those in My house will be in the Spirit. Those in My house will have the gifts of the Spirit. Those in My house will be lead by My appointed leaders.

Those in My house will fear Me and not man. Those in My house will do the things I did and greater things they will do. Those in My house will be one with Me as I am one with My Father.

Who will come to My house? Those who walk by faith and not by sight will come to My house. Those who are tired of a milk diet will come to My house. Those who are willing to change and drink My new wine will come to My house. Those who are tired of having their ears tickled will come to My house.

Those in My house will be complete, competent, and compatible in body, soul and spirit.” Amen.
