Listen to my cry and look up. Seek the light and come into the truth by obeying my commands. Walk not in the flesh but be born of the Spirit to receive power walking in my light hearing what the Spirit is saying and obey. Those who find the will of the Father become my brother and sister receiving their crown of life and their many rewards. They obeyed by being overcomers fearing the Father and not man by obeying the Word of God and the Spirit. They are friends and guests of the bridegroom wearing their robes of white washed in the cleansing blood of the lamb.

Who am I? I am the Alpha and the Omega who sees and knows all hearts with the authority to remove names from the book of life, who will judge fairly having no favorites. It is not what you eat, but what you do and say and whether you obey or disobey that I will either invite you in or I will shut the door leaving you outside. Put oil in your lamps by being born of the Spirit receiving the power to climb my Spiritual Mountain to come into the truth, the way and the life.” Amen. **Note—The Word of God says when you are born of the Spirit you will speak in tongues and praise God.**

Hearken to what the Spirit has said above. The Spirit's warning has no conflict with the word of God. Listen to what John wrote and warned. **1 John 3:9-10** **9** *Those who have been born into God's family do not sin, because God's life is in them. So they can't keep on sinning, because they have been born of God.* **10** So now we can tell who are children of God and who are children of the Devil. Anyone who does not obey God's commands and does not love other Christians does not belong to God (NLT)

If we do not obey what is written in the word of God we are sinners. John stated this in **1 John 3:8** **8** *But when people keep on sinning, it shows they belong to the Devil, who has been sinning since the beginning. But the Son of God came to destroy these works of the Devil.* (NLT) Jesus told the Pharisees that their father was the devil. **John 8:42-45** **42** *Jesus told them, "If God were your Father, you would love me, because I have come to you from God. I am not here on my own, but he sent me.* **43** *Why can't you understand what I am saying? It is because you are unable to do so!* **44** For you are the children of your father the Devil, and you love to do the evil things he does. He was a murderer from the beginning and has always hated the truth. There is no truth in him. When he lies, it is consistent with his character; for he is a liar and the father of lies. **45** So when I tell the truth, you just naturally don't believe me! (NLT)

The word of God is the truth and does not lie. If Christians believe not and apply not the complete word of God in their lives professing Jesus Christ who is the living truth, they are in unbelief which is sin. Christians and churches that pick and chose scriptures from the word of God to satisfy the flesh man ignoring the complete word of God make the word of God non effect in their lives. This is sin being the spirit of antichrist. Sin separates Christians from God. Christians can believe they are doing many wonderful works for God but Jesus Christ warned if it is not the will of the Father theirs works are of iniquity. Fear God and draw near to God as you work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. I pray you finish this study that you may receive knowledge, wisdom and understanding finding and doing the will of the Father in you life. Amen.

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Part One

What Is The Will Of The Father?

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The answer to the question cannot be one simple statement summed up in a few words. Part of the answer will be found in the scriptures listed. This is not all of the scriptures that speak of the will of God. Without being students of the word of God day by day, month by month and year by year, we will never find the will of the Father in our lives. In years past the Lord spoke this to me concerning judgments that has been and will continue to come because of the sins of this nation and the world. “What is will no longer be and what is to be will be the opposite of what was.” When the Lord first spoke this He was referring to the physical. This past month the Lord also showed me this is spiritual as well and applies to Christians. “What is will no longer be” is speaking of a Christian that is seeking the truth and the will of the Father moving beyond the principles of the doctrine of Christ. What that Christian is today that Christian will not be tomorrow. Because tomorrow: “what is to be will be the opposite of what was.” That Christian as he is growing into maturity cannot be what he was yesterday. Each day as we walk with Christ we must continue to put off the old man and put on the new man in the image of Christ.

I have added this new part which I will call part one to the booklet the Holy Spirit had me write in May 2004 titled “Are We Doing The Will Of The Father?”. The 2004 writing becomes part two. Part two have been revised as directed by the Holy Spirit being the will of the Father. As we grow in Christ, Christ gives us knowledge, wisdom and understanding of the Father by the Holy Ghost. I pray that you take your time and just not read but study the scriptures below that you may do the will of the Father as you continue to come into the maturity of Christ. Otherwise all our works will be works of iniquity. Heed the warnings of what the apostle Peter wrote. **2 Peter 3:5-7, 11-14** *5 They deliberately forget that God made the heavens by the word of his command, and he brought the earth up from the water and surrounded it with water. 6 Then he used the water to destroy the world with a mighty flood. 7 And God has also commanded that the heavens and the earth will be consumed by fire on the day of judgment, when ungodly people will perish. 11 Since everything around us is going to melt away, what holy, godly lives you should be living! 12 You should look forward to that day and hurry it along--the day when God will set the heavens on fire and*

the elements will melt away in the flames. 13 But we are looking forward to the new heavens and new earth he has promised, a world where everyone is right with God. 14 And so, dear friends, while you are waiting for these things to happen, make every effort to live a pure and blameless life. And be at peace with God. NLT) Amen.

1 Kings 8:56-58 56 Blessed be the LORD, that hath given rest unto his people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of Moses his servant. 57 The LORD our God be with us, as he was with our fathers: let him not leave us, nor forsake us: 58 That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and his statutes, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers. (KJV)

It is God's desire that all walk in his ways. We will be inclined by the Lord to do this if we read and obey the word of God. This is the will of the Father. If we have not obeyed the word of God, then how can we listen to the Spirit to hear what the Spirit is sayings?

2 Chronicles 6:14 He prayed, "O LORD, God of Israel, there is no God like you in all of heaven and earth. You keep your promises and show unfailing love to all who obey you and are eager to do your will. (NLT)

We as Christians can be doing many things in the name of the Lord and Jesus Christ. But if we don't examine ourselves to see if we are obeying the all the word of God all our works may be in vain.

Psalms 103:21 21 Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure. (KJV)

Even the angels in heaven praise the Lord and do his will.

Psalms 143:10 Teach me to do your will, for you are my God. May your gracious Spirit lead me forward on a firm footing. (NLT)

David cried out to God "teach me to do your will". We must follow David's example and we will if we become students of the word of God being washed in the word of God. Then we will obey the commands of Christ written in the word of God and by the Spirit as we hear the Spirit. By drawing near to God, we will stop sinning and begin to obey doing the will of God as He leads and teaches us.

Matthew 7:21-23 **21** *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.* (KJV)

Please look and understand what Jesus is saying in these verses. Jesus said many thought they were doing the works of the Father but they labored in vain because it was not the will of the Father. There are church programs, pastor's game plans, and Christians doing works in the name of Jesus but if it is not the will of the Father all is works of iniquity.

Matthew 18:12-14 **12** *How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray? 13 And if so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he rejoiceth more of that sheep, than of the ninety and nine which went not astray. 14 Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish.* (KJV)

We Christians being the sheep of Jesus Christ, the children of God, if we go astray after confessing Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit tries to woe us back into the will of the Father that we may obey and not be lost. Remember God will not strive with His lost sheep forever as God disciplines us. That is why many brothers and sisters in Christ are weak, sick and dying because we obey not the commands of Christ.

John 1:10-13 **10** *He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. 11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not. 12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: 13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.* (KJV)

Jesus came into the world of flesh and blood to do the will of the Father. By the obedience of Jesus we who are in the world can be born of water and of the spirit which is of God being the will of God who is our Father. Through Jesus Christ and by the Holy Ghost according to the word of God our sins are forgiven and we have the power of become sons of God.

John 4:34 Then Jesus explained: *"My nourishment comes from doing the will of God, who sent me, and from finishing his work.* (NLT)

Our spiritual nourishment is complete only if we are doing the will of the Father. If we are doing works in the name of Jesus Christ that is not the will of the Father, then we only feed our flesh man.

John 5:30 *I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.* (KJV)

Even Jesus Christ listen to the Father that the Father's will would be done. How much more should we listen to the Spirit to hear what the Spirit is saying that we may complete the will of the Father in our lives?

John 6:29 29 Jesus told them, *"This is what God wants you to do: Believe in the one he has sent."* (NLT)

John 6:38-40 38 *For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me. 39* *And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. 40* *And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.* (KJV)

This is the will of the Father to believe Jesus Christ whom the Father sent. If we confess we believe, then we must obey what Jesus Christ spoke in the word of God and what Jesus Christ is speaking each day by the Spirit. By finding and doing the will of the Father, we will not hear on the last day *"And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."*

John 7:16-18 16 *So Jesus told them, "I'm not teaching my own ideas, but those of God who sent me. 17* *Anyone who wants to do the will of God will know whether my teaching is from God or is merely my own. 18* *Those who present their own ideas are looking for praise for themselves, but those who seek to honor the one who sent them are good and genuine.* (NLT)

We as Christians must remain within the doctrine of Christ. To remain within the doctrine of Christ, we must know the word of God. Otherwise we can follow the wrong doctrine that speaks about Christ but not within the doctrine of Christ being deceived about the will of the Father and our eternal salvation.

John 9:31 **31** *Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.* (KJV)

1 Corinthians 1:1 *Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother,* (KJV)

This scripture passage shows us that God has a will for all Christians. That will of the Father or the calling or anointing comes from heaven without repentance. It is our responsibility to find and do the will of the Father that we all may do our part as the body of Christ being His Church. Remember His Church is where two or more are gathered together in Jesus Christ's name.

2 Corinthians 7:9-10 **9** *I now rejoice, not that you were made sorrowful, but that you were made sorrowful to the point of repentance; for you were made sorrowful according to the will of God, in order that you might not suffer loss in anything through us. **10** For the sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation; but the sorrow of the world produces death.* (NASB)

It is the will of the Father that after we confess Jesus Christ and sin again that through sorrowful repentance asking for God's forgiveness it will be done. It is the will of the Father that none be lost but it is our responsibility to work out our own salvation with fear and trembling.

2 Corinthians 8:3-5 **3** *For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. Entirely on their own, **4** they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the saints. **5** And they did not do as we expected, but they gave themselves first to the Lord and then to us in keeping with God's will.* (NIV)

See the will of the Father here. The Saints gave themselves to the Lord and followed His will. We must be very careful and not give ourselves to man or his denomination and follow their plans and we won't if we are students of the word of God finding and knowing the will of the Father in our lives.

Galatians 1:4 **4** *Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:* (KJV)

It is by God's order obeying the commands of Jesus Christ written in the word of God and listening to what the Spirit is saying to the churches that we do according to the will of God.

Ephesians 6:5-7 **5** *Slaves, obey your earthly masters with deep respect and fear. Serve them sincerely as you would serve Christ. 6 Work hard, but not just to please your masters when they are watching. As slaves of Christ, do the will of God with all your heart. 7 Work with enthusiasm, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. (NLT)*

Colossians 1:9 **9** *For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; (KJV)*

To be filled with God's will we must be filled with the word of God by being students of the word of God. We are to work out our own salvation will fear and trembling because faith without works is dead.

Colossians 4:12 **12** *Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God. (KJV)*

How do we stand perfect and complete in all the will of God? We have to obey all of the commands of Jesus Christ written in the word of God. If we read not the word of God, then we do not the commands of Jesus Christ becoming sinners being condemned with the world on judgment day.

1 Thessalonians 4:3 *For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication: (KJV)*

1 Thessalonians 5:18-22 **18** *In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. 19 Quench not the Spirit. 20 Despise not prophesyings. 21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. 22 Abstain from all appearance of evil. (KJV)*

1 Timothy 1:4 *Don't let people waste time in endless speculation over myths and spiritual pedigrees. For these things only cause arguments; they don't help people live a life of faith in God. (NLT)*

What Paul was writing to Timothy are warnings giving us examples of what is not the will of God in our lives.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 **16** *All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It straightens us out and teaches us to do what is right. 17 It is God's way of*

preparing us in every way, fully equipped for every good thing God wants us to do. (NLT)

The thing God's wants us to do is His will and the word of God will make it so if we obey the word of God.

Hebrews 10:36-39 *36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. 37 For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry. 38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. 39 But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul. (KJV)*

If we go back to sinning after receiving Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, we will be worse off on judgment day than if we never knew Christ and the right way to live.

Hebrews 13:14-16 *14 For this world is not our home; we are looking forward to our city in heaven, which is yet to come. 15 With Jesus' help, let us continually offer our sacrifice of praise to God by proclaiming the glory of his name. 16 Don't forget to do good and to share what you have with those in need, for such sacrifices are very pleasing to God. (NLT)*

If the above sacrifices are very pleasing to God, then we are doing the will of God in our lives. Only those who do the will of the Father in heaven will enter into the New Jerusalem which will come down out of heaven.

1 Peter 2:15-17 *15 It is God's will that your good lives should silence those who make foolish accusations against you. 16 You are not slaves; you are free. But your freedom is not an excuse to do evil. You are free to live as God's slaves. 17 Show respect for everyone. Love your Christian brothers and sisters. Fear God. Show respect for the king. (NLT)*

1 Peter 3:17 *For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing. (KJV)*

Remember the examples in Hebrews Chapter 11. It is God's will that some receive blessings and favor from God and some will suffer losing their lives in their allegiance to God and his better promises.

1 Peter 4:1-2 *1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin; 2 That he no longer should live the rest of his*

time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God. (KJV)

1 Peter 4:19 *So if you are suffering according to God's will, keep on doing what is right, and trust yourself to the God who made you, for he will never fail you.* (NLT)

What Christians must understand is that we will suffer as we do God's will in our lives. The most vicious attacks will come from other Christians who are complacent with their relationship with God. They will be your friends until you decide you want more of God. As you seek and receive more knowledge, wisdom and understanding of God, these friends will not want to hear or receive what God has given you by the Holy Spirit.

1 John 2:17 *And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.* (KJV)

Jesus Christ is coming for His church as it is written in Revelation and He will destroy all that have not confessed him or that are not doing His will. I remind you again of **Matthew 7:21 21** *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.* (KJV)

1 John 3:22-24 22 *And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. 23* *And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. 24* *And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.* (KJV)

What John is describing in the above scriptures is that if we do the will of the Father in heaven, we will receive of him on this earth and our crown of life in heaven after our earthly tent is folded and put into the ground. We all die once and then comes judgment.

1 John 5:13-15 13 *I write this to you who believe in the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life. 14* *And we can be confident that he will listen to us whenever we ask him for anything in line with his will. 15* *And if we know he is listening when we make our requests, we can be sure that he will give us what we ask for.* (NLT)

John makes a profound statement in verse 14 that God will listen to our prayers if those prayers are in line with the Lord's will. Until we begin to obey the whole word of God, do we walk in the light of Jesus Christ? Didn't

Paul write that many were weak sick and dying because they, being Christians, were taking the body and the blood of Jesus Christ unworthily? Jesus said not my will but your will be done Father. We must find and do the will of the Father as we walk the narrow path that few find.

I ask you this question. What will get you into heaven, following the doctrines of a denominational church that picks scriptures from the word of God or knowing and obeying the word of God doing the will of the Father which is in heaven? God is the I Am to be feared and obeyed who sent his only begotten Son to be sacrificed for the sins of the world. The gate to salvation is straight and the path is narrow and only few find it. Only by doing the will of the Father may we see and enter into the New Jerusalem. Doing the will of the Father means we have obeyed the commands of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Part Two

Are We Doing The Will Of The Father?

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Those who do not know the will of the Father in heaven can be illustrated as a farmer who owned many hogs. They were always jumping over and digging under the pen that contained them. Upon escaping their confines the hogs dug up the farmer's garden and his wife's flower beds which were against the will of the farmer and his wife. The hogs stayed not and waited not upon the farmer's direction and commands. They went about doing what they wanted making messes for the farmer to clean up. The hogs were always under the farmer's discipline for they climbed over and dug under and waited not for permission from the farmer.

What is the will of the Father in heaven? Who knows his thoughts and plans? Can we professing Christ today persuade the Father in heaven as Moses did? God laid his plans from the foundation of the earth knowing the beginning and the ending. God only knows the dates of all things to come. God has been revealing his hidden plans to his chosen ones since the beginning as necessary for that time and situation. As God's time line moves along to the end he is still revealing his secrets hidden in his Word. Who is God revealing those secrets hidden in his Word to in this day?

The will of the Father has always been to have communion with all of

his children he has called as he did with Adam. By Adam's sin death came upon the world but God has been longsuffering for his people the ones he calls. Throughout the history of man God has always sought that communion. After Adam it was the patriarchs God called and used. God called Abraham and through his descendants the nation of Israel was born to be God's chosen ones. But in all this time God had other plans that he revealed by his prophets about a Messiah that would come to remove the sins of the world and defeat the death that Adam brought about by sinning. God, knowing all, knew that what his son Jesus did on the cross for the world would not accomplish what God has always wanted that being communion with all of his children. The only way to God is by Christ but if we sin against the commands of Christ, we remain infants in Christ and God still lacks the communion he desires with his children called Christians in this day. God changes not and he is still revealing his plans and secrets by his prophets he has called and prepared. Those prophets are warning in this day as the prophets of old warned—repent and turn back to God and be holy as God is holy by obeying the commands of Christ to be in the will of the Father. Christ is coming for his Church as described in the Word of God. Jesus will have his Church and his death on the cross will accomplish his Father's will as Jesus prayed in John 17. God's plans will be completed and we will suffer judgments that we may repent and do the will of the Father.

When did Christians first begin to disobey the commands of Christ ignoring the will of the Father? We know that Paul, Peter, John and Jude warned of false teachers twisting the Scriptures and in the last days Christians would not endure sound doctrine. We know that Paul argued with and corrected false and incorrect teachings throughout his life as he served Jesus Christ. God is revealing by the Holy Spirit in this day when the incomplete teachings began. God is showing us that since Adam he has been longsuffering and patient for our sakes and those he called before us. That it is by God's grace and mercy many have been saved. We must remember what Jesus said—***Matthew 19:25-26*** **25** *When his disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved? 26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.* (KJV)

We will find in the book of Acts the first record of the incomplete teachings of Christ. This man was an apostle of Jesus Christ that was taught by Jesus Christ. He walked in the power and anointing of the Holy Ghost being born of the Spirit on the day of Pentecost. His gifts were without repentance and God used him mightily and he was caught away in the Spirit. What was he not teaching and doing? He was not teaching Christians or

praying for them to receive the Holy Ghost. Even Peter and John were sent by the apostles in Jerusalem to Samaria to check on what Phillip was doing. Peter and John found out that the Holy Ghost had not come upon any of those new Christians being taught by Phillip. They were only baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Peter and John prayed for those Christians to receive the Holy Ghost and laid hands upon them. The new Christians received the Holy Ghost. Later God sent Phillip into the desert when he found a eunuch of the queen of the Ethiopians and preached to him and baptized him in the name of Jesus Christ only without teaching about the Holy Ghost. Then Phillip was carried away in the Spirit. See Acts 8:4-40.

I never saw this truth until the Holy Spirit showed it to me as I read the book of Acts. This truth was revealed to show that God has been long suffering and merciful beyond our understanding or abilities. Phillip was in sin disobeying the commands of Christ and yet God used him. But we must not take this example and tell ourselves even though we know the truth of the Word of God that we can preach and teach incompleteness disobeying the doctrine of Christ. Why, because God is changing things to bring the true Church of Jesus Christ to light by discipline and judgments. I share this parable and teachings with you from the Holy Ghost.

A Parable: Follow The Instructions

There once was a world wide company that had local plants in almost every city and village in the world. Its board of directors had an open door policy. Any of the plant managers or the workers could write or call about suggestions to improve productivity or to discuss any problems about the plant or plant personnel.

All the plants had a written book of policy that the managers were to follow in order to make the finest product in the entire world. All products produced were of the same quality and met the specifications set up in the book of policy.

A problem of change began to occur that was not authorized in the policy manual. Some of the plant managers started talking and meeting together discussing ways to change production and the final product. They thought they could institute these changes unknown to the board of directors to save time and work in producing the final product. Other managers world wide heard about these changes and meetings. They also met and made changes in production convincing the workers all was okay and the finished product would still meet specifications.

Everyone thought they were doing excellent work by making the changes. Now the managers and production workers had more time off. They did whatever their hearts desired. They ran here and there chasing their own desires and fulfilling the lusts of their flesh. The board of directors saw all of this going on and never said a word to anyone in the plants for a long time. The board saw and knew that the product had become imperfect and did not meet the original specifications. By now the board had their own plans to correct all that was wrong. When the plan is implemented there will be great cries of anguish among the managers and plant workers, because it will mean back to the policy manual.

***Matthew 24:44-51** 44 You also must be ready all the time. For the Son of Man will come when least expected. 45 "Who is a faithful, sensible servant, to whom the master can give the responsibility of managing his household and feeding his family? 46 If the master returns and finds that the servant has done a good job, there will be a reward. 47 I assure you, the master will put that servant in charge of all he owns. 48 But if the servant is evil and thinks, 'My master won't be back for a while,' 49 and begins oppressing the other servants, partying, and getting drunk--50 well, the master will return unannounced and unexpected. 51 He will tear the servant apart and banish him with the hypocrites. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (NLT*

The Spirit spoke this to me in prayer and said make it a parable—"The church is making Christians, but leaving them to wither and die, for the church is weak, immature and lacking itself." The above parable is by the Holy Spirit. I listened and recorded. Then the Spirit started asking me questions and making statements.—Does the community fear the church? Does the church fear God or man? Look at yourself—Are you living the Word or talking about the Word. Do you have heart love or head knowledge? Pastors and leaders—What is your daily time in the Word, prayer and fasting? Are you living the Word or giving it lip service? Are you a good or poor example for the sheep? For the sheep follow and do what the leader does good or bad. Live the Word and God will come alive from the pages of his Word. Believe like children—By faith accept God's Word as it is written and follow and obey God's Word.

***Psalms 50:16-23** 16 But God says to the wicked: "Recite my laws no longer, and don't pretend that you obey me. 17 For you refuse my discipline and treat my laws like trash. 18 When you see a thief, you help him, and you spend your time with adulterers. 19 Your mouths are filled with wickedness,*

and your tongues are full of lies. **20** You sit around and slander a brother-- your own mother's son. **21** **While you did all this, I remained silent, and you thought I didn't care.** But now I will rebuke you, listing all my charges against you. **22** Repent, all of you who ignore me, or I will tear you apart, and no one will help you. **23** But giving thanks is a sacrifice that truly honors me. **If you keep to my path, I will reveal to you the salvation of God.**" (NLT)

Isaiah 42:13-15 **13** The LORD will march forth like a mighty man; he will come out like a warrior, full of fury. He will shout his thundering battle cry, and he will crush all his enemies. **14** He will say, "**I have long been silent; yes, I have restrained myself. But now I will give full vent to my fury; I will gasp and pant like a woman giving birth.** **15** I will level the mountains and hills and bring a blight on all their greenery. I will turn the rivers into dry land and will dry up all the pools. (NLT) God has before and God will again judge his people that they may repent and live.

Isaiah 56:10-11 **10** For the leaders of my people--the Lord's watchmen, his shepherds--are blind to every danger. They are like silent watchdogs that give no warning when danger comes. They love to lie around, sleeping and dreaming. **11** And they are as greedy as dogs, never satisfied. They are stupid shepherds, all following their own path, all of them intent on personal gain. (NLT) They fear man and not God being fools without knowledge and wisdom. Their own complacency will destroy them. They obeyed not Christ's commands walking their own path that leads to death doing salvation their own way.

The Lord has shown that he has been silent and in his love, grace and mercy being longsuffering and patient. The Lord has let things go and we Christians think there are no problems and we are in the will of the Father doing his works. God has his thoughts, ways, and plans and it will be by his Word (the policy manual) and obedience to his Word (the policy manual). God's will is being done on earth as it is in heaven and that means we must change to be in the will of the Father by listening to what the Spirit is saying to the churches.

In my search for the truth of God's ways, plans and thoughts by the Word of God and from the Holy Ghost as he teaches to be in the perfect will of the Father I am reminded of this proverb—**Proverbs 25:2** **2** *It is God's privilege to conceal things and the king's privilege to discover them.* (NLT) God being the Alpha and the Omega laid out his plans from the foundation of the earth. But many of his plans are hidden until it is time for them to be

revealed. Paul even wrote about God's secret plans being revealed in God's timing. John wrote Revelation when God revealed some of his plans to John by angles and the Holy Ghost in outline form to warn each generation to always be prepared and ready for the coming of Jesus Christ. Today the Father is still revealing his secrets that we may be and remain in his perfect will. But to receive these secrets there are conditions we must abide by that we may have the privilege of discovering God's secrets. ***Psalms 25:10-14***
10 The LORD leads with unfailing love and faithfulness all those who keep his covenant and obey his decrees. 11 For the honor of your name, O LORD, forgive my many, many sins. 12 Who are those who fear the LORD? He will show them the path they should choose. 13 They will live in prosperity, and their children will inherit the Promised Land. 14 Friendship with the LORD is reserved for those who fear him. With them he shares the secrets of his covenant. (NLT)

How blessed are Christians today because we have a road map called the Holy Bible (the policy manual) which is the inspired Word of God assembled and ready at our finger tips in many languages and translations. We are without excuse if we claim we cannot understand what God is saying and teaching in his Word.

The Word of God and the will of the Father in our lives are layered. There is the surface layer of the Word that we can read without power and anointing to find out what we must obey as we begin our works in Christ and that is the Father's will. This first layer is for all Christians after they have confessed Jesus Christ with their lips and by faith believing in their heart that Christ was raised from the dead. In the four gospels they will find the commands of Jesus Christ called the doctrine of Christ that they must obey. This is the will of the Father for us to do and should be taught by those who lead us to Christ. But the sad facts are that once we are lead to Christ, we are told we are saved by grace and left flapping in the wind being untaught or being taught the doctrines of man and his church. This is not the will of the Father. These actions reinforce what Jesus spoke to the scribes and Pharisees—***Matthew 23:14-15***
13 But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in. 14 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation. 15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

(KJV)

How important is it for all Christians to receive understanding that we will find and do the will of Father in heaven? Jesus left no doubt about the will of the Father when he spoke in—**Matthew 7:21 21** *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.* (KJV)

The will of the Father is that none of his children will be lost. Who are his children? Is it the children of the world or is it the children confessing Christ? What does the Word say? Peter answers the question in 2 Peter who was writing to Christians words of warning and encouragement and not to the world. Included are two translations. **2 Peter 3:9 9** *The Lord is not slow about his promise, as some think of slowness, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish, but all to come to repentance.* (NRSV) **2 Peter 3:9 9** *The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.* (NIV)

But we are only his children called sons and daughters if we hear the Word and obey the Word. Those who have been lead to Christ but are in sin of disobedience to Christ's commands are those who God waits on to repent that they will not be lost. For the day is coming and in minutes it will be upon us that God will end his longsuffering allowing us into heaven by his mercy and forgiveness of our sins of disobedience to his Word. In our spirits we Christians know something is about to change and those walking not in the Spirit are beginning to fear because they lack understanding of what God is about to do. In these changes Jesus will make ready the Church he is coming for. And God is saying enough of waiting in patience and longsuffering for Christians to repent. God is saying I will no longer be silent but will judge that we may repent and obey the policy manual as it is written. In judgments and chaos the Church Jesus is coming for will be birthed and brought to light for all to see. We can only belong to his Church by obeying all of his commands he spoke. In these judgments if we die where will we stand with our salvation and redemption if we are in sin of disobedience and without repentance? Even those in the world know in their spirit trouble is brewing and they fear for their lives. In judgments they will be given the chance to repent and come to Christ and obey his commands.

Yes, we are saved by grace and not by our works. But when we receive God's grace, we must be taught to receive understanding. We must obey the commands of Christ as spoken by Christ working out our own salvation with fear and trembling. **Philippians 2:12** *Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have*

*always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. (KJV) By grace we are saved, but by our works we keep our salvation. Our most important works are obeying the Word of God and which is the will of the Father. Without our works of obeying our faith is dead. **James 2:26 26** For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works (obedience) is dead also. (KJV) Then are we righteous or are we sinners? Remember—**1 Peter 4:18 18** And "If the righteous are barely saved, what chance will the godless and sinners have?" (NLT)*

What will happen to churches and Christians in these judgments that are without repentance? New proselytes or Christians and old Christians can be illustrated like leaves on a tree with the tree illustrating the church and its leaders. Each spring the leaves are born and each fall they die and drop to the ground. Season after season this continues. Without being taught or searching the Scriptures we know not the will of the Father about being born of water and of the Spirit. We are in disobedience to the Word of God walking in darkness claiming the light of Christ. Each generation becomes like leaves on the tree falling to the ground to die never to rise incorruptible. We never come into the image of Christ leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ coming into perfection. When Christians and churches without power and anointing from heaven by the Holy Ghost never finding the will of the Father in heaven, they only come into the image of the doctrines of that church. Their works are in vain. Each generation is like leaves on a tree falling to the ground dead. They claim to have the light of Christ but walk in darkness leading multitudes to their death doing not the will of the Father in heaven knowing not Christ and having not the love of Christ. **1 John 2:3-6 3** Now by this we may be sure that we know him, if we obey his commandments **4** Whoever says, "I have come to know him," but does not obey his commandments, is a liar, and in such a person the truth does not exist; **5 but whoever obeys his word, truly in this person the love of God has reached perfection. By this we may be sure that we are in him: 6** whoever says, "I abide in him," ought to walk just as he walked. (NRSV) It is our works of obedience to the commands of Christ that builds our faith and then we will be doing the will of the Father as Christ did. Christ only did what he saw the Father do being in his perfect will. **John 5:19-20 19** Jesus replied, "I assure you, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does. **20** For the Father loves the Son and tells him everything he is doing, and the Son will do far greater things than healing this man. You

will be astonished at what he does. (NLT)

The leaders of those churches are blind and deaf. They filter out the things of the Spirit from heaven by their doctrines. They promise much but deliver nothing being without the Holy Ghost and his power and anointing. How terrible it will be for them as they lead their congregation to their death by sinning against the Word of God. The congregation would have been better to have never learned about Jesus Christ than to accept him and then sin in disobedience against the commands of Christ that he taught his apostles. **2 Peter 2:17-21** **17** *These people (church leaders) are as useless as dried-up springs of water or as clouds blown away by the wind--promising much and delivering nothing. They are doomed to blackest darkness. 18 They brag about themselves with empty, foolish boasting. With lustful desire as their bait, they lure back into sin those who have just escaped from such wicked living. 19 They promise freedom, but they themselves are slaves to sin and corruption. For you are a slave to whatever controls you. 20 And when people escape from the wicked ways of the world by learning about our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and then get tangled up with sin and become its slave again, they are worse off than before. 21 It would be better if they had never known the right way to live than to know it and then reject the holy commandments that were given to them (NLT)*

The powerless church is like the tree growing new leaves each generation. They allow their leaves to die and in the fall of their years they drop to the earth never coming into the truth of the Word of God. They never received the Holy Ghost and his power and anointing, never allowing Christ to be the head, never operating in the gifts of the Spirit and never found the will of the Father in heaven. What will be their rewards? Jesus' answer to that question leaves no doubt in the minds of those walking in the truth. **Revelation 3:15-16** **15** *"I know all the things you do, that you are neither hot nor cold. I wish you were one or the other! 16 But since you are like lukewarm water, I will spit you out of my mouth!" (NLT)* Jesus wants us to do the will of the Father so that we will not lose what we are seeking in Christ. Jesus backs up Peter's teaching about being better off not knowing the truth than to know it and disobey by sinning.

My heart grieves for those Christians in the powerless churches because of what is about to happen. My heart grieves for the leaders in those powerless churches as they walk in ignorance lacking the knowledge of the truth and some having the knowledge of the truth but fearing man and the church they serve and not God. They live all their lives suffering God's

discipline because of the sin of disobedience to the Word of God because they were not taught all things that Christ commanded to be taught. **Hebrews 12:8-13** **8** *If you are not disciplined (and everyone undergoes discipline), then you are illegitimate children and not true sons. 9 Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of our spirits and live! 10 Our fathers disciplined us for a little while as they thought best; but God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in his holiness. 11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. 12 Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. 13 "Make level paths for your feet," so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed.* (NIV)

What a sad path they are walking. They walk in sin not being able to make the paths level for those who follow them causing them to fall also. **1 Corinthians 11:29-32** **29** *For if you eat the bread or drink the cup unworthily, not honoring the body of Christ, you are eating and drinking God's judgment upon yourself. 30 That is why many of you are weak and sick and some have even died. 31 But if we examine ourselves, we will not be examined by God and judged in this way. 32 But when we are judged and disciplined by the Lord, we will not be condemned with the world.* (NLT) Pray for them that in God's judgments and discipline they will allow their eyes and ears to be opened to repent and come into the truth. Then they will no longer walk a path that seems right but ends in death. Pray that they may be set free by obeying the commands of Christ becoming his disciples to find and do the will of the Father.

If we do not know the will of the Father in our lives, are the works we are doing in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost pleasing to the Kingdom of God? The will of the Father in our lives depends on our maturity and our obedience to the commands of Christ. As shown earlier the will of the Father of a new Christians is to learn and be taught about Christ and his commands that we may become Christ like in our walk on the earth. The Father has a plan and a will for all of us, but to fulfill that plan we must do his will at each stage of our growth as we come into the perfection of Christ leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ. God is a personal God loving each of his children and desires intimacy with each of us by the Holy Ghost in his Word and in our prayer closet. New Christians must be taught the basic steps to maturity, which are to be born again, born of water and of

the Spirit, put off the old man putting on the new man in the image of Christ, being washed in the water of the Word, seeking God and his will in our prayer closet and partake of communion with Christ daily by the breaking of the bread and drinking of the wine. The Word of God lays out these basic steps by commands and examples of the early Church. This is the will of the Father.

Remember God is a God of diversity. We all are to walk our own path working out our own salvation with fear and trembling. Only by being born of the Spirit, can we walk that path with the Holy Ghost as our guide in the Word and in our prayer closet because God is a Spirit. The path one walks can be an entirely different path than what another walks. One may suffer as he walks that path for Christ and another may not suffer. This is the will of the Father and Hebrews chapter 11 provides examples to give us understanding. By the Holy Ghost the Father can show us very early in our Christian life the plan he has for us and the job he wants us to do. But, we must look to the Word of God for the examples of the callings the Father gave to others such as Moses, David, John the Baptist and even Jesus. They all knew yet they waited and prepared by the will of the Father. They were tested and tried by the Father to see if they would stay the course the Father laid out before them. Then they did the will the Father doing the job the Father gave to each of them. We today are no different because God changes not.

We must follow the examples of those who went before us in the Word of God that did the will of the Father. We must not follow the bad examples of the others in the Word of God. Only by doing the will of the Father can we enter into the Kingdom of Heaven.

John 13:15 *For I have given you an **example**, that ye should do as I have done to you.* (KJV) In the four gospels Jesus gave us example after example for us to follow and gave us his commands to follow that we may do the will of the Father in heaven as he did the Father's will.

1 Corinthians 10:6 *Now these things were our **examples**, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted.* (KJV) The Word of God gives us the examples we are not to follow as the children of Israel did. For in their lust the Father disciplined them with judgments until they repented.

Hebrews 4: 11 *Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same **example** of unbelief.* (KJV) The writer of Hebrews tells us that salvation must be completed by our works with faith obeying the will of the Father in our lives otherwise we can fall into unbelief forfeiting our day of rest.

Hebrews 8:5 *They serve in a place of worship that is only a copy, a shadow of the real one in heaven. For when Moses was getting ready to build the Tabernacle, God gave him this warning: "Be sure that you make everything according to the design I have shown you here on the mountain."* (NLT) Even though Moses was doing the will of the Father in heaven he was warned do it right and according to the plans and will of the Father in heaven and not do it the way of his thinking.

James 5:10 *Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an **example** of suffering affliction, and of patience.* (KJV) When we do the will of the Father we can look foolish in the eyes of others but we have the examples of the prophets as they suffered with afflictions knowing we must have their patience to endure being overcomers receiving our rewards in heaven.

1 Peter 2:21 *For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an **example**, that ye should follow his steps:* (KJV) When we are called of the Father and do his will in his time and when we suffer we can look to Christ for an example to follow.

Jude 1:7 *Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an **example**, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.* (KJV) By this example the Father warns us what happens when we lust after the flesh whether strange or otherwise by not doing his will and what the rewards will be living our lives our own way.

It is only as we walk our path laid out by the Father daily do we find his will daily in our lives. We will become like Jesus as we are washed in the Word of God and seeking God in our prayer closet after being born of the Spirit. Then daily as we walk with the Father we will be in communion with the Father as Jesus was. By the Holy Ghost we will hear what the Father is saying knowing the will of the Father in our lives. This was the desire of the Father from the beginning and by Christ's death and resurrection the Holy Ghost came giving us power and anointing to hear and do the Father's will in our lives.

Living in the will of the Father daily in our lives individually by being born of the Spirit with the heavenly witness of speaking in tongues; we are given power and anointing by the Holy Ghost. Then when we assemble ourselves together the beauty of the Church Christ is coming for blossoms into full bloom. For by the Holy Ghost, Christ is our head individually and assembled together Christ remains our head with the Holy Ghost being the

communicator between the body of believers and Christ in heaven. That assembled body will be submitted to one another in unity and one accord recognizing and accepting direction from anointed leaders Christ has given his Church. That body will encourage and warn one another by giving witness of to the will of the Father in their lives. In this witness the understanding of the Father and his will is expanded among the body as to what his plans thoughts and ways are. Remember God does not use a cookie cutter to make us all the same. That body will operate in the nine gifts of the Spirit to give encouragement and warning to each other using the words of Christ by the Holy Ghost and not using the fleshly thoughts of man. The body will strengthen themselves making level the paths for their feet so that the new and immature Christians in the body will not become disabled, but rather healed to do the will of the Father being trained for their day of salvation. This body doing the will of the Father individually and corporately will be the Church Jesus told me he is coming for as spoken by the Holy Spirit.

“My Church will be a living organism as the human body is alive and all parts work together. My Church will work together in the gifts of the spirit with governmental oversight. My Church will be militant and victorious having the keys of the Kingdom binding and loosing, connected with heaven and united. My Church will be one universal church in various localities. My Church will be in one accord, one heart, one mind with unity in the name of God, with unity in the Word of God, unity in the glory of God, unity in the love of God. My Church will be a glorious Church. My Church will be in My perfect will and not in My permitted will. My Church is not a material building, a denomination, a nationalistic enterprise, or Judaism extended, is not the kingdom of God and not parenthetical. My Church is of My eternal purpose. I set My Church in order by blessings and judgments before I come. I tarry not, I come.” To receive the in depth teaching of what Jesus spoke by the Holy Spirit see or ask for the booklet titled ‘The Church Jesus Is Coming For.’

I will share with you some testimony that knowledge and understanding of the will of the Father may be increased. When we confess Christ as our Lord and Savior, Jesus claims us and angels in heaven cheer. We are saved by grace and not by our past works in the world. We were all sinners until we were born again seeing the Kingdom of God by confessing Jesus. We now belong to God and he begins to do his will in our lives. It is our responsibility and we should be taught that by others who have opened and walked the path before us. They should teach us to come into the Kingdom

of God by obeying the commands of Christ which now becomes our beginning works for Christ which is the will of the Father.

By God's grace and mercy and I have been able to walk that path but with difficulty until I was born of the Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. Then the Holy Spirit became my teacher. On August 6, 1995 I confessed Christ at the age of 52 in the Nazarene church in Meade, Kansas. The Father's will was that he healed me supernaturally of Crohn's disease that I suffered with for many years. Immediately I quit taking all medications and for six months of I was free of the dreadful disease. At the time I had no understanding of how God heals and that one can lose his healing. This was not taught in that church for they had no power from above to teach spiritual warfare. Six months later and I know now but didn't then the date and the time I let the devil back in with his disease as I was without knowledge back then. The devil came back with a vengeance. I sought knowledge from other sources for I knew that God had healed me. I read the Bible and I read other books on healing and it was God's desire to heal his children. With my limited knowledge I prayed to God for my healing and I continued to seek knowledge. Then by faith in 1999 while still attending the Nazarene church I confessed my healing of the Crohn's to the Sunday class I was teaching. That is another story. God honored my confession and faith, but this time I had to taper off of all of my medications. As I grew in the word of God, I found in the word of God that God's gifts are without repentance. That God never takes back what He gives us. If we remain without knowledge and wisdom from God, we will perish never understanding why.

The Lord moved me to a full gospel church in Liberal, Kansas shortly there after. I saw in that church the Holy Ghost and his power working just like it was described in the books I had been reading. I heard people praying in tongues and using the gift of tongues. I wanted what they had. I prayed to God and I cried out to God and I was baptized in the Holy Ghost in June of 1999. When I received the Holy Ghost in that prayer line in the church, the Spirit slew me and as I went to the floor I began speaking in tongues. I lay on the floor speaking in tongues and praising God.

It is the will of the Father that we obey the commands of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and to follow his example. It is our responsibility to do the Father's will in our lives that we may have communion with the Father daily as we live and walk on this earth. With that communion by the Holy Ghost we can hear and obey what the Father is saying. For example, about that time in my life each morning before breakfast I was taking four Nuprins for pain in the joints of my hands and the rest of my body. One morning as I

poured the pills into by hand the Holy Ghost said ‘you don’t need those’. By faith I put the pills back into the bottle and set them on the shelf. The Holy Ghost taught me to bind the pain in the name of Jesus and command it to leave my body and I could do this over and over as necessary without an overdose. I did and I am still doing it today. To be Christians walking in the image of Christ we must take what is given from heaven by the will of the Father and use it. James said faith without works is dead.

By God’s grace after I confessed my healing of Crohn’s I had no battles with Satan trying to give the disease back to me. Upon being baptized with the Holy Ghost speaking in tongues, I received power and ability in spiritual warfare. God gave me the ability from heaven by the Holy Ghost. It is our responsibility and God expects us to use that power to keep the devil defeated. Then for many times in many months at night for hours at a time racked in pain I fought the devil and his attacks by faith and praying in the power of the Holy Ghost. The devil tried to convince me I was not healed. He would speak to me in my mind to call the doctor you are dying, go to the hospital emergency room you need immediate medical attention. But then I knew he was a liar not to be listened to. When daylight came the symptoms left until another night. The devil made one last try when I was in a meeting at Oral Roberts University. Sitting in the meeting the devil started manifesting the symptoms back upon me and I spoke out this phrase to the devil—“oh no you don’t” and that ended the attacks. By receiving the Holy Ghost with his power and his ability I did the will of the Father doing spiritual warfare to keep the healing I received by prayer and faith. With faith there must be works. Always remember that God’s plans, thoughts and ways are greater than ours. As we walk with the Father we cannot assume that what the Father did for us in the past is going to be his will for us in the future. We must always be in communion with the Father by the Holy Ghost at all times as Christ was. Otherwise we may miss what the Father is doing and grieve the Holy Ghost.

For an example, I will fast forward to September 2002. The first Friday in that month after arising and preparing for the day I had a sensation come upon my body. The left side of my body felt numb and at the same time had a tingling sensation about it. The Lord spoke to me by the Holy Ghost and told me to lay down in bed which I did. I immediately started praying in the Holy Ghost as I laid there. The sensation lifted somewhat and I knew in my heart I should go to the VA hospital. They ran some tests checking me for a stroke and sent me to the lab for blood tests. That morning the line was long and I begin thinking to myself, not speaking to the Lord, that I could just walk out of here and pray to the Lord and be healed. Upon completing that

thought the Father spoke to me by the Holy Ghost with great clarity—“If you leave here you will suffer greatly”. I knew then in my spirit to stay the course that the VA laid out to me for treatment and medication this being the will of the Father. With further testing in Little Rock they found no indication of a stroke. Knowing that the will of the Father was for me to stay in the VA medical system for other treatments and I have done so. In that time I have had two surgeries. Yes God is the healer and he can heal us supernaturally or he can direct us to seek healing by man. We must be walking in communion with the Father allowing him to guide and direct us by the Holy Ghost in all areas of our life to be in his will. For me I will continue to remain in the VA medical system and I will still continue to use Jesus as my pain pill until I see the Father’s will for me to do otherwise.

We must listen to the Spirit and obey. We cannot and never will know God’s thoughts, plans and his ways that we can assume something and do it on our own. God will share the secrets of his covenant with us by the Holy Ghost and we can see what the Father is doing just as Jesus did. But only if we are Christ’s disciples obeying and being in the truth of the Word of God and hearing and obeying the Spirit. I pray that the above testimony I have shared has increased your knowledge and wisdom gaining understanding about the will of the Father in heaven. The Father’s will is omnipresent in our lives because God is a Spirit in all places at all times. God is a God of diversity loving all and wanting communion with his Children being omnipresent in our lives always leading us down his path so that we can be overcomers if we will let him. The kingdom of God is entered into with much tribulation and only by being born of water and of the Spirit may we enter in. Remember Hebrews 11, that in our walk with Christ some receive blessings from God and some suffer loving their lives not unto death. We are the clay and the Father is the potter. God is righteous in all things he chooses to do with his clay and if we are in the will of the Father we will receive strength and ability from the Holy Ghost to walk the path the Father has laid out before us to be overcomers receiving our rewards in heaven.

Again I remind you just how important is it for all Christians to find and do the will of the Father in heaven. Jesus left no doubt about the will of the Father when he spoke in—***Matthew 7:21 21*** *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.* (KJV) We become fools if we chose to walk our own path and assume we are doing the will of the Father. I will remind you again following the example of Peter in ***2 Peter 1:12-13 12 I*** *plan to keep on reminding you of these things--even though you already*

know them and are standing firm in the truth. **13** Yes, I believe I should keep on reminding you of these things as long as I live. (NLT)

Here is what the Holy Ghost taught about Christians walking the different paths not in the will of the Father. And what happens to the Christian walking the Father's path in his will. First let us read the Word of God to find these answers taught by the Holy Ghost.

1 Corinthians 3:10-15 **10** Because of God's special favor to me, I have laid the foundation like an expert builder. Now others are building on it. But whoever is building on this foundation must be very careful. **11** For no one can lay any other foundation than the one we already have--Jesus Christ. **12** Now anyone who builds on that foundation may use gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. **13** But there is going to come a time of testing at the judgment day to see what kind of work each builder has done. Everyone's work will be put through the fire to see whether or not it keeps its value. **14** If the work survives the fire, that builder will receive a reward. **15** But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builders themselves will be saved, but like someone escaping through a wall of flames. (NLT)

Matthew 7:21-23 **21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. **22** Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? **23** And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (KJV)

The Holy Spirit taught me by the Word of God there were three different groups of Christians being spoken about in the above Scriptures. We must be in the spirit and born of the Spirit to hear what the Spirit is saying and to wait upon the Spirit which is the will of the Father. Otherwise how can we be taught by the Holy Spirit who is our teacher?

The Lord has been taking me back to Matthew 7:21-23 time and time again in this past year. I used both of the above scriptures in the booklet 'How to Prepare to Be Qualified to Serve in the Army of Jesus Christ' as warnings that Paul and Jesus gave us about our works. Then one morning in prayer the Holy Spirit opened my mind to the truth of who these different Christians are.

The key to part of the answer is in Matthew 7:21-- *but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.* Jesus spoke of doing the will of the Father many times in The New Testament. How do we come to know the will of the Father? We have to have been born again, born of water (water baptized) and of the Spirit (baptized by the Holy Spirit with evidence of

speaking in tongues), put off the old man and put on the new man in the image of Christ, be washed in the water of the Word of God, come to know God in our prayer closet and take of the communion with Christ daily (our first love). Other words we are working out our own salvation daily with fear and trembling. In doing these things we will come to know the voice of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit and will be led by the Holy Spirit to do the will of the Father.

In 1 Corinthians 3:14 Paul states that if the work survives the fire, that builder will receive a reward. Jesus in Revelation states in chapters two and three that we must be overcomers to receive the rewards awaiting us in heaven. If the work survives the fire and a reward is given, then that Christian has done the seven steps to maturity working out his own salvation with fear and trembling having found the will of the Father which is in heaven and is obeying the Spirit doing the will of the Father. He will rule and reign with Christ on earth for one thousand years.

In 1 Corinthians 3:15, the builder's work was burned up with the builder suffering great loss. But the builder was saved but like someone escaping through a wall of flames. That Christian received no reward and suffered greatly to be saved only to receive his crown of life. He was disobedient to the commands of Christ, never being born of the Spirit and never knowing the will of the Father walking in darkness by his flesh always under the discipline of God because he professed Christ as his Lord and Savior. But by God's mercy he is saved, not being in unrepented sin but in the sin of lack of knowledge. He will be with Christ on earth for the thousand years, but he will not rule and reign with Christ. **Revelation 3:19** *19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. (KJV)* **Hebrews 12:8** *8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. (KJV)*

In Matthew 7:22 Jesus was speaking to those that will not enter into the kingdom of heaven for they knew not the will of the Father in heaven. Yet they prophesied in his name, cast out devils in his name and did many wonderful works in his name. These are Christians who have been born again, born of water and born of the Spirit reading just enough of the Word of God to grasp the promises of God and believed and had the faith to do the works above. But they never were washed in the Word of God and never came into intimacy with God from within their prayer closet. They never knew the will of the Father in heaven and were not led by the Spirit but by their own desires thinking they were doing works pleasing to God. Jesus said to them depart from me you that work iniquity.

This day the Holy Spirit is reminds me and I pass it along to you that there is another group of Christians that has been and is and will be to come that are greatly honored in heaven. They overcame the devil by the blood of Christ never wavering in their testimony even unto death for they were overcomers as Christ overcame death on the cross. They will not only rule and reign with Christ on earth for a thousand years but at the end of that thousand years they will not even be tempted by the devil when he is loosened. They have passed all the tests by dying for Christ following the example of Stephen in the book of Acts and are ready to enter into the New Jerusalem. They feared not knowing this home was only temporary and a better home awaited them in heaven. The Father always gives us strength in all things when we live by faith in his will doing the works he wants us to do. **Revelation 12:11** *And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.* (KJV)

Brothers and sisters the Word of God is very clear as to whom we are to be in Christ and we are to obey the commands of Christ. He is the living Word coming unexpectedly for his Church and we are to be ready at all times. Are we ready right now today to celebrate Christ when he comes in power and glory or will we hide in caves crying out for the rocks to fall on us. God changes not and Jesus is the same always. We must change obeying the Word of God today to be ready for the living Word tomorrow. As a professing Christian, are you being lead by the Spirit knowing the will of the Father in heaven and hearing the Spirit doing the will of the Father in heaven? God have no favorites and we will all be judged by what we say and do in this life. I pray that you will be speaking the truth of the Word without compromise doing the will of the Father in heaven to receive not only the crown of life but all the rewards laid up in heaven where moth and rust cannot touch.

Let us not be fools but fear the Father and what he can do to our spirit and soul. Let us be doing the will of the Father everyday and obey the Word of God and the Holy Spirit to be ready for our salvation. Let us not sleep with the world committing whoredoms by being drunkards for the markets of worldly materials. Let us be lovers of Christ having intimacy with the Father being lead by the Holy Ghost and God will supply all of our needs as we seek the kingdom of Heaven first and its righteousness. Let us be holy as the Father is holy. The Word of God commands it. Let us enter into the Kingdom of God with much tribulation. The Word of God commands it will be so. Amen.

In closing I leave you with additional teachings from the Holy Spirit received while praying in my prayer closet during the month of April 2004.

04-15-04. Our calling by God on this earth is carried forward in the world to come. Those who think they will be sitting around in heavenly mansions will find there is work to still be done in the worlds to come. Learn now in this life what the Holy Spirit teaches to be ready in the world to come to use that teaching to do the will of the Father pleasing God in all things. Even in the new world we will always have a choice to obey or disobey. And like the angels we can be thrown out of the New Jerusalem if we exceed our authority being stiff necked. Then we will be sitting outside the gates never being allowed back in. In tears we will cry out to God asking for mercy and there will be none. Amen.

04-16-04. In a dream there stood a man and as people approached him he absorbed them into his body and they were seen no more. Only the man stood and he was unchanged. The Holy Ghost spoke—“Churches that build brick and mortar without power from heaven are like the man in the dream. The people enter into the physical building and are not seen; only the building remains. On the inside of the building the people mature not spiritually for there in no heavenly power and anointing. Those who enter in remain unchanged only to stand and age physically like the building they enter into. They know not the truth living a lie being separate from me and my kingdom. They are dead spiritually and dying physically each day on their way to the grave and death never gaining what they thought they had believing the words the building spoke.” Amen.

04-18-04. While praying in the spirit I saw this word in the Spirit and as I wrote it down the Holy Spirit gave me the definition of the word. “Itemite” pronounced “*Item mite*”—My children who worship me in the flesh and not in the spirit and truth. Day by day I itemize the charges against them to be read off on that day pointing out to them that they are without excuse losing what they think they have for they listened not or obeyed not the one raised from the dead who teaches the truth by the Holy Ghost. Amen.

04-19-04. The Holy Spirit spoke—“I have wisdom and knowledge to give freely to those who seek me in spirit and truth. I give answers to those who draw near to me. I give answers to those who humble themselves before me. I give answers to those who seek my kingdom and my

righteousness. I give answers to those who put on my full spiritual armor everyday. I give answers to those who read my Word. I give answers to those who in their prayer closets. I give answers to those who do my will walking the path I have laid out before them. I give answers to those who obey and speak my Word without compromise fearing me and not man. I have **no** answers for those in disobedience to my Word for I answer not the prayers of those in sin. I tarry not; I come to receive those who have come into perfection as it is written.” Amen.

The Lord Jesus spoke—“In the gospels where I spoke always separate and distinguish between the parables I spoke and the literal truth. This is done only by being born of the Spirit to understand the spiritual things that I spoke that was given to me by my Father. The blind and there are many in this day who have appointed themselves leaders twist the Scriptures to their understanding in the flesh and by the flesh. They lead others into the ditch with them never having the truth. They are blind guides to be ignored by those born of the Spirit who find the will of the Father walking the path of salvation listening to and obeying what the Spirit says.” Amen.

Brothers and sisters in Christ please heed these words of Christ that you will run the race being overcomers loving your live not unto death. **Matthew 7:21-27** **21** *Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. 24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock. 26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.* (KJV)

Remember only those born of the Spirit can inherit the kingdom of God and enter into the New Jerusalem. **1 Corinthians 15:47-50** **47** *The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven. 48 As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly. 49 And as we have borne the image of the*

earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly. 50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. (KJV)

There is no easy way or short cuts into the kingdom of God. It is only by the Father's will and His order obeying His word that we may have his unfailing love. Amen.

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
